ORDINANCE NO. 412- Ordinance Relating to Animals and Fowl.

It is unlawful for any person to keep or harbor any animal other than dogs, cats, gerbils, hamsters or caged household birds within the City of Butterfield. This Ordinance will be enforced due to our in-town industry, Butterfield Foods, helping to eliminate any potential bio security risk. If you have any chickens on your property a letter will be sent out asking you to remove the chickens from your property. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and the sheriff's office may be called to have the chickens removed.

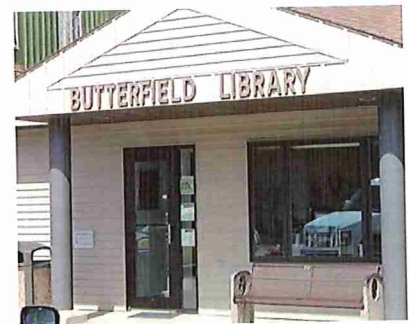
Es ilegal que cualquier persona tenga o albergue cualquier animal que no sea perros, gatos, jerbos, hámsters o aves domésticas enjauladas dentro de la ciudad de Butterfield. Esta ordenanza se hará cumplir debido a nuestra industria local, Butterfield Foods, para ayudar a eliminar cualquier riesgo potencial de bioseguridad. Si tienes gallinas en tu propiedad, se enviará una carta solicitándote que las retires. Cualquier persona que viole alguna disposición de esta ordenanza será culpable de un delito menor y se podrá llamar a la oficina del sheriff para que retiren las gallinas.
