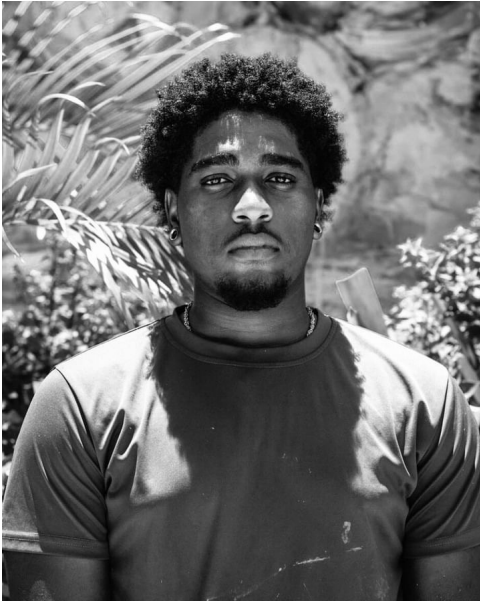


Eddion Whyms Biography
