

Justin Moultrie Biography



Justin Moultrie (b. August 11, 1996 Nassau, Bahamas) is a visual artist working primarily in the medium of Acrylic paint and Oil pastels. He has pursued an AA in Fine Arts at the University of the Bahamas, where he was inspired to become a painter.

Moultrie uses paint and pastel to depict images of Bahamian life, vibrant Bahamian life and landscape, spiritualism and the relationship between humans and nature.

He has participated in several group exhibitions at multiple Bahamian galleries such as Central Bank of the Bahamas, Sixty2sixty, Hillside and most recently I.C.E Gallery, where he is currently a resident artist. Other notable participations include the Musicians Artists and Vocalists Showcase (MAVS) festival, and the Soundwaves charity Auction for Jennie Street. His artwork appears in many prominent collections in The Bahamas, and has been commissioned to paint portraits of Olympic runners.
