In March, the drought was affecting the Kona coffee blossoms and, in the process, alarming the farmers and growers as we watched for signs of withering blooms. Luckily, like clockwork, the rains started in April and haven't abated showering the trees each afternoon. The 150 newly planted trees on the farm will be ready in three years for picking.

Although it is early we are expecting our first harvest in July; the first harvest usually begins in late August. With the prospect of a good season, we should be picking between now and February.

Sausage with Red-Eye Gravy and Biscuits



Instructions:

- Warm 2 tbs. olive oil in a large skillet over high heat.
- Add 1 lb. bulk pork breakfast sausage and cook, breaking up the chunks, until no longer pink.
- Transfer to a plate using a slotted spoon.
- Reduce heat to medium and add 1 tbs. of olive oil.
- Sprinkle 2 tbs. all-purpose flour over oil and cook, stirring constantly 3-5 minutes.
- Add 1 cup of **KonAroma** and bring to a simmer over medium-high heat. Season with salt and pepper.
- Reduce heat to low and stir in 2 tbs. packed light brown sugar and 1 tbs cream.
- Add sausage to skillet and serve with biscuits.
