

# Maine Summer Vacation

July 21 - 25, 2024

5 Days, 4 Nights



## Sunday ♦ Travel Day

Today we'll journey north to the great state of Maine, also known as Vacationland. We will start our Maine adventure in Cape Neddick for a photo stop at Maine's southernmost lighthouse, Nubble lighthouse. Next we enjoy a Lobster - choice dinner at Jonathan's Restaurant in Ogunquit, Maine. After dinner, we to Portland, Maine's largest city-by-the-sea and check in to a full-service hotel, the Best Western Merry Manor Inn in South Portland for the night. (D)

## Monday ♦ Bath, Maine

Travel to the beautiful Mid-coast of Maine where we will tour the Pemaquid Lighthouse, one of Maine's most scenic beacons and the light featured on the Maine state quarter. Climb to the top of the lighthouse or visit the Pemaquid Fisherman's Museum on site with artifacts from the fishing and lobstering industries and lighthouse service.

Next we travel a short distance to Damariscotta where will have free time to grab lunch and shop in the unique shops.

This afternoon, enjoy a special aquaculture outing on an oyster farm cruise. Learn how oyster farmers prepare the farm equipment and sow the world-famous Damariscotta River oysters while bald eagles, ospreys and migratory birds.

We will check in to the Hampton Inn on the waterfront in Bath, Maine for a 2-night stay. A welcome reception or treat bags are provided on arrival. The hotel is located just steps from the Kennebec River waterfront with restaurants and shops in the historic neighborhood of downtown Bath. Our hotel features an indoor pool & jacuzzi.

Dinner included this evening at a local restaurant. (B, D)

## Tuesday ♦ Boothbay Harbor

This morning we board Cap'n Fish's tour boat for a Puffin Nature Cruise. This special summer-only cruise is a magnificent "Seafari" for all nature lovers with seals, blue heron, an occasional whale and other coastal wildlife along the way. We will cruise around Eastern Egg Rock where the puffins congregate only this time of year.

There is free time in Boothbay Harbor for lunch on own and to explore the local galleries, boutiques and plenty of casual restaurants from which to choose from for lunch.

This afternoon, we meet our local guide for a tour of Boothbay Harbor highlights, including historical sites, charming seacoast neighborhoods, hear legends and history of Boothbay's connection with the sea. You'll see two unique churches and drive past the island homes along picturesque Ocean Point.

Continue north to neighboring Rockport Harbor which is favored by photographers and sailors alike. Marine Park boasts a statue of Andre the Seal, a tribute to his home here in Maine. You'll hear about the local history of the ports and famous people who hail from this region.

Next, visit the Boothbay Railway Village which represents a turn-of-the-20th-century Maine village containing railroad memorabilia, antique cars and trucks and such restored buildings as a blacksmith shop, red schoolhouse and general store as well as the 1847 Boothbay town hall, Freeport railway station and Spruce Point chapel. A ride on a narrow-gauge, coal-fired steam engine is included.

Here we will enjoy a traditional lobsterbake dinner at the Boothbay Railway Village's 1847 Boothbay Town Hall: This is Boothbay's Town Hall and the town's annual meeting still takes place here each May. It was built in 1847 for just \$700. The design of the building is Greek Revival with post and beam construction and a beautiful vaulted plaster ceiling. The stage and balcony were later additions. It was moved to its present site in 1990 from Boothbay Center – about 1 ½ miles down the road. (B, D)

### Wednesday ♦ Bath & Portland

Today, we tour the Maritime Museum. Located on the bank of the Kennebec River, the museum depicts Maine's shipbuilding industry from the 1600's to present day. There are numerous hands-on exhibits, boat building demonstrations, a lobstering exhibit and a special lighthouse exhibit.

We will have free time in Bath for lunch and shopping.

This afternoon we have a narrated tour of Portland, Maine with a photo stop at the Portland Head lighthouse, the most photographed lighthouse in America.

Our final dinner in Maine is at Dimillo's on the Water. This unique Portland waterfront restaurant was once a large car ferry that operated between New Castle, Delaware and Pennsville, New Jersey. (B, D)

**One Day Trips** Full payment or a per person deposit is due within 7 days of making your reservation which confirms your seats: Coach seating assignments are based on the date your first payment is received at our office.

#### Day Trip Payment Policy:

Sightseeing/Attractions/Dinner Theater: \$30 PP  
Deposit

Ticketed trips (Show, Concerts, etc.): Deposit varies  
Day Trip that require full payment with reservation will be noted at the end of the trip description.

**Day Trip Cancellations** made within 60 days before the trip date are subject to a penalty fee equal to the amount of monies that have been advanced on your behalf for components of the trip. These include but are not limited to event/show tickets, pre-ordered meals, transportation, attraction & sightseeing costs. Please note that some event/show tickets are non-refundable once we receive your deposit. Cancellations within 14 days prior to the Day Trip are subject to no refund unless a replacement is found by you or us.

#### Multi-day Motorcoach Payment Policy: A minimum \$150 pp deposit is required.

Payments made on multi-day motorcoach tours are accepted by check, cash or credit card. You can choose to (1) pay in full at reservation or (2) pay your deposit at reservation and final payment by the balance due date.

**Air Tours & Cruises Payment Policy** can vary depending on the policy of the cruise line or third party tour operator.

If you choose to **pay by credit card**, either **one or two payments will be accepted**. The first credit card payment required is the minimum deposit amount (or more if you desire). The second credit card payment required is the final balance amount due by the "Balance due" date listed on the payment schedule.

#### Multi-day Tour & Cruise Cancellation Policy

Cancellations are subject to any non-recoverable expenses or penalties charged by hotels, transportation companies, sightseeing companies, airlines, cruise lines & attractions, as well as a cancellation administration fee charged by C and Bea Tours & Cruises.

**Multi-day Cancellations Prior to Trip** 60 days or more, on most trips, a refund less any non-recoverable charges and 90 days on most air tours & cruises.

60 - 30 days - \$150pp cancellation administration fee plus any non-recoverable charges.

29 -8 days - \$200pp cancellation administration fee plus any non-recoverable charges. Cancellation penalties from cruise lines and tour operators will be assessed and will increase as the trip departure date approaches.

Within 7 days - trips may be 100% non-refundable unless a replacement is found.

Regarding airline tickets, an airline cancellation fee of up to 100% of airfare is usually in effect immediately upon ticket purchase.

**Optional Travel Protection** will be offered on our overnight tours and cruises providing coverage for canceled or interrupted trips, medical costs, travel accident, lost or stolen luggage, bankruptcy and acts of terrorism. We will send you the insurance information to you with the receipt of your first trip payment. **We strongly recommend the travel insurance to protect your vacation investment.**
