the gospel has not been accepted yet, in hopes of using the window of opportunity to reach the people with the gospel and someday plant churches.

The team brought and donated 5 precious puppets; so we wrote a cute evangelistic script for them to tell the story of how germs affect our bodies, how to prevent them from harming us in the future while ministering the free gift of salvation. Karen used agar dishes acquired from Camp Living Water in Ms, with samples of the tap water and fingerprint impressions to illustrate that bacteria is everywhere and can harm us if we aren't careful. Bacteria galore were visible on the agar dishes and proved that our local tap water was unsafe to drink or cook with. The health program motivates the church to be a witness for Jesus and gets them involved in their communities all the while bringing a health awareness to the public. Thank you Tambra for sharing of your time, \$, and heart to touch the lives of those in Mexico with your obedience.

It is our hope to offer the purified water to the local churches so they can distribute them to their communities also. The systems that are up and running in other parts of the world operate on





fold purpose. We arranged our schedules so we could transport them wherever the Lord would so lead. We met them in the State of Tlaxcala where they held medical/hygiene outreaches while Pat taught the men how to install the purification plant. We then broke up in two teams once we came into San Andres. The men went on a spiritual warfare assignment and the women did Med/Hygiene clinics.

The women gave out pills to rid the people of all ages of parasites and we taught on good hygiene practices so they can remain free and clean of the parasites that cause the majority of diseases and sicknesses here. Teaching them not to re-infect themselves by to finalize all the legalities before it's fully operational. But once the water purification system is up and running, we hope to offer purified water to people at affordable prices to help them remain free and clear of diseases associated with dirty water.

We did two clinics in our area of San Andres Tuxtla, two in La Barra,(fishing village on the Gulf), two by the Waterfall, and two in a small village community that has been closed to the g

that has been closed to the gospel due to religious strongholds. Casa de Gloria



is registered with the government as a civil organization which simply means we are a humanitarian organization looking out for the well being of the public. With this type of registration, we are able to go into the public school system and teach, not preach. But we can invite them to come to a later service in which they can hear the gospel message preached. A neat thing happened in La Barra, one classroom of Jr. High kids came to where we were instead of us going to them as was scheduled which gave us the freedom to share of God's goodness openly and publicly.

To see such a receptive and hungry crowd in each village was remarkable. We saw over 500 people in the state of Tlaxcala and 1000 + in our area! We were welcomed and invited back everywhere we went. And the other pastors in the Kingdom Conquerors are eagerly waiting for their turn in their village for a clinic. So our work schedule has already begun and we have yet to unpack! PTL!

Because of the sensitivity of the matter, I can only briefly tell you about the men's



mission. The men hit the spiritual high places and accomplished their prayerful tasks victoriously. Their mission this trip stretched over three states and Mexico City. This was their second time in our area. We are hearing positive reports of areas they attacked last year that have been successfully destroyed. One particular area, according to a local witch, doesn't have the same power it once did and therefore the witches are forced to go elsewhere to do their work. The team was honored to attend Citlaly's 15th Birthday celebration as shown in the picture above . She rescheduled her festive day to insure the groups' attendance. Gloria registered as Civil; it allows us to freely go into public places including schools, to present wholesome topics such as this health program. Although the team has since gone, Tambra has left the unused medicines with us to carry on the disbursements. Our first priority is to schedule strategic areas to administer the medicines where the gospel has not been accepted yet in hopes of giving us a foot in. We wrote an appropriate script for a puppet team to tell the story of how germs affect us and how to prevent them from harming us. It was the first time Casa de Gloria ever experienced the behind the scenes of puppetry and were thoroughly excited. In fact, the whole health program motivated the church to be a witness for Jesus and get involved in their communities. Everyone looks forward to continue to bring the puppets and health program to the remote areas of San Andres and beyond. Thank you RN Tambra for sharing of your time, \$, and heart to touch the lives of those in Mexico with your obedience.

Allen and Doris Tyndall of Kannapolis, NC in September invited us to attend 5 days at a Mississippi Water Purification System Training camp sponsored by the Presbyterians. With the help from their church, First Concord Assembly of God Church in NC, they purchased two water purification systems that we are were able to install in Tlaxcala and San Andres. We are in the process of finalizing the paperwork so we can begin to offer affordable potable drinking water to these two communities. With the hygiene classes the communities are learning the importance of using purified water and abstaining from contaminated tap water when brushing teeth, cooking, and caring for the baby plus the importance of maintaining clean hands at all times. It's easy to see how good hygiene practices will keep the doctor away.
