I pray this letter finds you in good health and enjoying each new day the Lord bestows upon us. I want to give you a quick reminder and special prayer request for an upcoming scheduled trip to Mexico for July 15-24, 2014.

Pat, and two very good friends for many years; Guy Monjure, and Jeff Fredericks, will be driving a van loaded with donations of books, bibles, medical supplies, shoes and clothing from Amite, Louisiana to San Andres Tuxtla, Veracruz.

The tentative itinerary for the trip is as follows:

Upon arrival at the border, they will spend the night in Texas on Tuesday, July 15th and meet with a Mexican Pastor on Wednesday morning, July 16th to swap the cargo into his van, which we donated to him last year. His van is in dire need of 2 new or nearly new 16" tires if anyone would like to bless him, please contact us before July 16th.

The reason being for the cargo switch is due to Mexican law concerning vehicle permissions for US citizens. Upon arrival in Reynosa, Mexico, they will share in a local church Wednesday night. Pastor Manuel will then drive them down to San Andres on Thursday morning, July 17th. Pastor Manuel is a traveling Pastor/Evangelist and is very familiar with the travel route and is savvy with the danger of the drive especially through Cartel territory.

They plan to arrive in San Andres Tuxtla by Friday evening, July 18th. Special services for the youth, leaders, and church family will be held on Saturday, July 19th and also on Sunday, July 20th for the regular am service downtown Centro and then in the afternoon in La Barra, the fishing village on the Gulf of Mexico.

Monday, July 21st they will hold a special meeting with the leaders of the church to admonish them in their endeavors and encourage them to continue to reach the lost in Jesus' name.

Tuesday, July 22 they will begin their journey back to Louisiana with a border stop to exchange vans on Wednesday, July 23 with projected arrival back in Amite, Louisiana for Thursday, July 24th, Pat's birthday!

The main reason for this trip is to encourage the body of believers in Casa de Gloria that they are not abandoned but Christ is their refuge and strength. For

years God has delivered many a prophecy confirming the fact that Casa de Gloria is HIS special work and He is taking care of it.
