We coasted along the side of the road until it could go no further. We were miles from anyone on the loneliest stretch of road possible. With my eyes shut I saw an angel on his knees assisting Pat as in the picture in the middle on the right, and two angels at the back of the trailer. I asked Pat what he did, and he replied, "Nothing, I did nothing." Yet the bus purred like its suppose to and drove fast past the notorious bad section of town. Then we were warned about robberies at the 50 km. mark just days before we left. So I'm watching and praying as we count mile markers like never before. We hit the 50 km marker and the bus is running perfect when all of a sudden Pat decides to just pull over. I frantically ask him what was he doing to which he replied he has to use the bathroom. I said, "Now??? with the 51 km marker in sight???" I guess he was giving God another opportunity to witness to a bad guy. The last obstacle we had yet to overcome was getting over the Baton Rouge River Bridge without the bus dying out. So guess what? Just as we get to the foot of the bridge it begins to sputter, sputter, and then die. I yelled out to God, "No!!" and prayed all the more then it got a second wind and up and over the bridge it went! I felt like I was on a roller coaster ride and as we topped the bridge I stood up and screamed with delight for it was all downhill from there!
