**** This issue of the newsletter we would like to highlight each village church, what God is doing there & work plans that you can help us with so you can better acquaint yourselves with the work in San Andres Tuxtla, Veracruz Mexico.****

We are so excited to announce that our water system plant is officially up and running as a government recognized water purification plant! Casa de Gloria has legally placed its water purification system as a humanitarian outreach under its new tax exempt status in Mexico! We believe this micro-business will one day help provide job opportunities for its members and help support its many pastors. We choose not to compete with the major providers of purified water but to target those who cannot afford drinking water. We offer a 5 gallon jug of water cheaper than a Coca Cola, something that is found in every home regardless of status or social level. One of the government's requirements is that we have an officially marked vehicle to transport the water to the individual's homes. We are also excited to share with you that we recently purchased a water delivery truck with the money from the upcoming sale of the Ford F150 donated to the ministry last fall. It was more economical to sell the truck here and use that money to purchase a national vehicle than it was to pay the over \$1200.00 USD to nationalize it plus \$ for plates and paperwork. Now Pat won't be seen delivering water on his motorbike, *NOT!* *Living*

Waters for the World is the English name of our purification plant and apart from the to the door delivery service, we minister to the clients' needs since this is a ministry tool God has placed into our hands. Most folks are receptive to prayer and the water is a great tool to get through their doors and know them on a more personal level. Raul and Hilario are two of our main water workers. But recently a third helper was added. His name is Eduardo. He is the son of one of our most faithful tithers, a single mom who is raising 8 children of her own plus her 3 grandchildren. Eduardo's income will help support his family. This water treatment plant facility is not far from being totally completed. This summer we hope to complete its second floor. We want to include stairs to the roof which already houses a water tank and want to close it in with block walls and windows. This project is estimated to cost \$3,800.00 USD. CHURCH IN BENITO JUAREZ



Hilario and Irma are two of CDG leaders who are faithful to work in this community on the far west side of town. Irma works with the children in their new Sunday school room which was built last summer. Hilario is currently serving as its pastor and is doing a fine job thus far. This July we will celebrate our 2nd anniversary. The church is saving and preparing a feast for the community. We hope to finish the cement block walls and

add windows soon in the Sunday school room because the wind and rain are blowing the attendance charts off the walls! Last year we bought the lot behind the building and hope to start construction on our much needed bathrooms this summer. The church has a few rotten windows we'd like to replace along with adding an alcove onto the front of the building. This cost for the entire project is expected to run \$6,800.00 USD.

LA BARRA

The church in the fishing village of La Barra is flourishing and is experiencing standing room only in its weekly services. With 305 habitants on this peninsula, roughly 80 adults, 25 teenagers and over 45 children are actively in the church every week. This year we would like to assist them with some much needed remodeling such as replacing the church's rotten rafters and pitted tin roof an estimated cost of \$1,400.00

Each week we are experiencing new members in attendance and are enjoying worshipping Jesus in such spacious accommodations! We are using this time as a test to see if we would like to purchase this facility at contract's end next January. It will take a

miracle because we will need \$150,000.00 USD to purchase it. Please Pray!!



MORELOS

Jose Luis and Candy are our pastoral team in this small community of 1,100 habitants. They are a sweet couple and truly have pastors' hearts for the people. They are expecting their 2nd grandchild this July. The church in Morelos is our oldest property location established approx. 4 years ago. It is the first and only evangelical church in the village. The retired Bus/RV serves as Sunday school class for the children and storage of equipment and folding chairs. A roof was erected 3 years ago and a concrete slab under

it was poured a year later. Now the rainy season can come and we don't have to slosh around in the mud. We recently stretched a barbed wired fence around its four corners to help protect it from beastly pestilence temporarily but we would like to enclose the site with a 2 1/2 foot tall knee wall of concrete block topped with hurricane fencing. Adding three gates to form the entrances; one the size of a door in the back left hand corner of the property and the other will form the entrance to the property with 2 car size gates. Estimate cost of project: \$3,000.00



LOS PINOS

Raul & Rebecca are our Pastor and Sunday school teachers in this small community of 1,217 people on the north side of the city. They are our youngest leaders and are expecting their first child in October. Raul is a hard worker and is passionate about everything he does in CDG for the Lord. Rebecca and the children love to take their Sunday school class outdoors under the banana trees. They are also literally fascinated with our new bathrooms. Rebecca told us that when the old existing bathroom was their only choice, the children opted to hold their desire to go to the bathroom until they got home because it was an outdoor potty with a curtain for a door. But now that CDG has beautiful ceramic tiled bathrooms, the children do the opposite and wait until they come to church to use

them, and often several times throughout each service. She states that they are fascinated with our "bathroom of luxury!" Recently Karen has taught for 9 weeks on using Jesus' authority to heal and was given the opportunity to pray for some of their members. The two women pictured in the far right corner suffered daily with epilepsy all their lives. After we prayed for them, they never had another attack. They are sharing their testimonies of God's goodness with their neighbors. We have great plans for this property. We would love to purchase the adjacent lot to allow us to expand our church and have road access to the International Hwy 180 where a digital billboard would be seen by everyone. We would also love to eventually finish the chain wall and build its main church for an estimated \$48,000.00 USD & \$20,000 USD to purchase the 33' X 195' lot.
