CELL GROUP REACHES NEIGHBORHOOD WOMEN:

Ines, leader of a home cell group, is inviting the women of her neighborhood and our church, to watch an instructional video series by Ruth Martinez of Monterrey, MX, entitled, The Virtuous Woman, Wife, and Mother. The women are responding to the series with such enthusiasm that Ines wishes to continue to show it until everyone she knows has seen it, including her fellow teachers from work. It is truly impacting the lives of everyone who watches it. The only problem we have at the moment is, according to the women, not showing it and others like it more often. It has stirred a hunger in the women to learn more about the practical Word of God and how it can be applied in their lives.

CONGRATUALTIONS TO CHANO AND ROSA:

It was super neat to watch the body of Christ, according to their means, assist and insure that Chano and Rosa bare a healthy baby this time. In five pregnancies, this is the first full term, normal size, healthy baby. And the first time her health has been good the whole 9 months and thereafter. One person went as far as to ask their family doctor to lend of his services. The government provided some free services like staples for her to eat and helped pay for any ultrasounds and blood work needed. Casa de Gloria along with other churches and individuals provided powdered milk chalked with vitamins, and groceries. So with the help of the body of Christ, Rosa's health improved. Saturday, August 5th, 2005 at 11:30 pm, Rosa went into labor. They walked over a mile in the pouring rain to the home of the doctor's friend who immediately took them to the hospital. Within 30 minutes, (at midnight) and two small pushes, Alejandro Fernando, a full-term, normal, healthy 2.5 kilo (5 lb.) baby boy was born.

Chanos' parents are aging quickly and are in fair physical condition. But his father's heart is problematic. He requires a medicine that for his economic state is unaffordable. (\$12.50 US for 10 tablets X 3 boxes = \$37.50 US currency) Casa de Gloria, and a local Christian doctor have been assisting him in obtaining the medicine but would like to offer this opportunity of helping a fellow brother in Christ to the whole church body.** *"Caring for the poor is lending to the Lord, you will be well repaid."* Proverbs 19:17 CEV
