NUMBERS DWINDLE DOWN

The new members of Casa de Gloria's August's church plant in Morelos are experiencing a mild portion of religious persecution. A religious denominational church in the village is creating obstacles to hinder the children from attending our services. They devise plans such as a clean-up program in the community which commits the teens to work during our church hours. They have also offered Tamales with gelatin as a motive to coax them away from services. Valentina, 8 years old, said
