Why Faith Journey

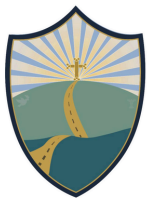
- Many with disabilities cannot attend typical parish classes.
- Parishes want to serve, but often lack trained educators and resources.
- Faith Journey bridges this gap, ensuring everyone has access to the Sacraments.
- Our goal is to nurture faith, strengthen parish connections, and lead candidates to Jesus.

What We Offer

- Preparation for Reconciliation & Eucharist (final approval lies with the parish Pastor)
- Adaptive lessons created to support the faith formation of individuals with disabilities
- Proudly Catholic, but open to all who aspire to better know, love, and serve the Lord
- Supported by parish coordinators and personal "Faith Mentors"
- Minimal cost: \$75 per candidate (scholarships available and donations welcomed)

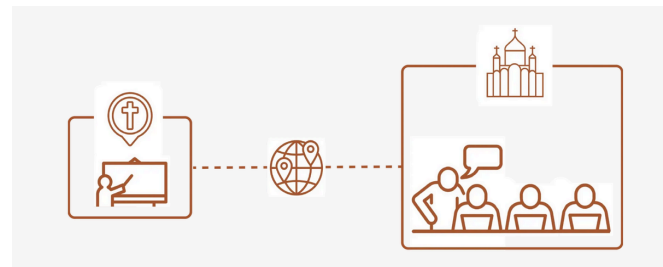
Our Innovative Approach

- Most lessons delivered virtually for accessibility
- Use of the Loyola Press Adaptive Kit and other resources to fit the diverse needs of the candidates
- Occasional local gatherings for fellowship and support
- No need for parishes to have specialized staff or resources: We provide them!



Typical Requirements

- Candidates: Individuals committed to preparing for the Sacraments but unable to take part in standard parish programs
- Parish Coordinator: A volunteer from the parish (no special education background needed) to help oversee participation.
- Faith Mentor: A supportive guide for each candidate, walking with them through preparation; mentors may come from the home parish or another local parish
