Why:

- Many with Disabilities cannot attend typical Parish programs.
- Parishes want to serve this population, but often lack trained educators.
- We bridge this gap, as all can attend this program.
- Our goal is to nurture Faith and strengthen Parish connections.

What:

- Preparation for Reconciliation, and Eucharist (final approval lies with the Pastor).
- Adaptive lessons, approved by the church, to support the faith formation of individuals with disabilities.
- Proudly Catholic, but open to all who aspire to better know, love, and serve the Lord.
- Minimal cost.

Our Approach:

- Lessons delivered virtually and are fully accessible.
- Lessons are taught by a certified special educator.
- All lessons are recorded for later review and replay.
- All attendees are people with disabilities.

Program Requirements:

- Candidates committed to enriching their Faith, but unable to participate in typical Parish programs.
- Baptized Catholics
- Attendance at weekly lessons.
- Registration and nominal tuition fee.
