4) The Thalhe Dance Festival is open to dance students, amateurs and pre-professionals of all nationalities, ages 18 years old and up.

5) Participants are welcome to register at multiple category, however, The Thalhe Dance Festival reserves the right to restrict the number of events a participant attends, or decline any registration at discretion (subject to space availability at each category).

6) It is the participant's responsibility to obtain a written approval to present any choreography, music, etc. for any piece that approval is required.

7) The dance category offered are going to be **Repertorie/Neo-Classical Ballet, Modern/Contemporary**, **Jazz/Lyrical, Tap, Hip-Hop and Free Style** for solos, duos, trios and groups Ensemble.

8) The category will be chosen at the time of the registration and cannot been changed after the registration.

9) Registration fees:

Registration/Administrative Fee: \$150 (this is a non-refundable fee that ensures the participants' place in the Showcase and includes complementary master classes offered) Solo: \$200 for first solo entry - Contact us for a coupon if you would like do perform a second solo and up Pas de Deux/ Duo- \$150 per dancer, per entry Trio - \$120 per dancer, per entry Small Ensemble (4 dancers) - \$100 per dancer, per entry Large Ensembles (5+ members) - \$75 per dancer, per entry

10) Registration will close when a venue has reached its maximum capacity. If you are still interested in registering for a venue that has reached capacity, you may register for the Wait List. No payment will be required or accepted. The Thalhe Festival will do their best to accommodate all participants.

11) The deadline for music submission is 2 weeks prior to the first day of the event. Penalties will be applied according the Penalty and refund policy.

12) Penalties and Refunds Policy Music and participants information Deadline (2 weeks before the first day of the Event)Musics and information submitted less than 2 weeks before the first day of the competition will acquire a \$20 penalty fee per entry will be added to your invoice. Any Music and information will not be allowed to be changed during the event and it's the participant responsibilities to send everything before the deadline. We encourage each participant to have a backup music with you.

13) \$150 Registration/Administrative Fees (per dancer) are non-creditable, non-refundable and non-transferrable for any reason whatsoever.

14) Category's refund requests are ONLY acceptable to the dancers that have been injured or unable to participate due an illness and informed to the administration before the first day of the Festival. In this case dancers will need to send a email to thalhefestival@gmail.com, accompany with a Doctor's letters must be on the office letterhead that include an ink signature and doctor's stamp.

15) Time Limits:

- Solo: Maximum 2:00
- Ensembles:

Classical Pas de Deux: Maximum - 6:00 (Adagio and Coda only) Duet/Trio (2-3 members): Maximum - 3:00 Small Ensemble (4 members): Maximum - 3:30 Large Ensemble (5+ members): Maximum - 4:30

16) Certificates

A certificate of participation will be given for each participant at the end of the Festival.

17) Costumes

Costumes are not mandatory for participation and are at the discretion of the participants. The Thalhe Festival requests that both music and costumes are respectful of the parts of the body on display as we will have a diverse audience including families with children.

18) Point Shoes

Point Shoes are not mandatory and it will be open for any gender. The Thalhe Festival is strongly committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all dancers and we encourage participants to just wear point shoes with previous experience.

19) Stage Rehearsals

It will be held on the day of the presentation. Sound, light and projection technicians will accompany the stage rehearsals, in order to guide the groups in the available resources. There will be control of entry to the stage and house mix and conference via ID. The order of stage rehearsals and presentations will be drawn up by the Festival Coordination and it will be available on the login system.

20) Evaluation Board

Even though The Thalhe Festival is non competitive Dance Festival, we believe on the development of our participants and we will have professionals in every category to give a feedbacks notes.

21) Master Classes

Master Classes with master teachers are an integral part of the experience and part of our educational mission. Though participation is not mandatory, we strongly encourage all participants to take advantage of this valuable part of the Thalhe's experience.

22) Badges

Each participant that has more than one entry will be allowed to have only one accompany badge. Groups with more than 5 participants are allowed to have 2 badges. The Badge is a complimentary pass to attend Open Stage with the dancer(s) and may be picked up at the Welcome Table. The person listed for the respective badge will only be able to obtain this badge by showing a valid ID. Badges will only be granted to the person specified in the form, regardless of the names entered in the "Accompany" field of your registration up 2 weeks before the first day of the event.
