2022 Virgil Ski Club

Dear Parents,

Attached are the details related to the upcoming 2022 ski/snowboard season at Greek Peak Mountain Resort.

The program is free to for Virgil residents in grades 3-6.

The program will start January 6, 2022 and continue on **Thursday** evenings – February 10, 2022. Program time is 4pm-7pm. In the event of cancellation due to weather, you will be contacted by a program advisor and that night is typically added on the end of the program. **There is no ski/snowboarding available the week of winter break (February 14-18).**

Students can continue to ski on their designated day/time (Thursdays 4-7pm) until march 14, 2022. **No adults will be on site for supervision after we complete 6 sessions.**

If your child is going to be absent, please contact an advisor by 4pm that day.

Kids who have rentals to return should begin making their way inside at 6:45. There are clocks on the lift, but a watch is helpful if they have one.

Bussing from Smith and Randall schools to Greek Peak is available (more information will be available as we get closer)

Rentals are Free for the included 6 sessions. If your child continues to come on Thursday evenings after ski club concludes, rentals will be 50% off.

Helmets recommended (\$43)- Sign up for this when you register your child online.

Meal Plan available (\$63) This includes a sandwich option, side and drink for all 6 weeks.

Parents must register their child(ren) online. New process this year.

- Go to Greekpeak.net
- Everyone must register for a new account
 - Returning guests can enter their email and click "forgot password". Even if you know your password, it needs to be reset.
 - Use parents email and child's information
 - You can add the meal plan, rentals, and helmet orders there.
- Sign online safety waiver
- This new registration is said to be available 11/3/21...you can also register over the phone if you wish.
- YOUR CHILD IS NOT ENROLLED IN SKI CLUB UNTIL BOTH THE ONLINE REGISTRATION IS COMPLETE AND PAPER FORMS ARE TURNED IN!!

Choose Your Child's Ability level:

- Never-ever (new color?)
- Green circle (beginner) This allows them on the lifts
- blue square (intermediate)
- black diamond (advanced)

- double black diamond (full access to all trails)
- Orange Oval (allow use of terrain park)

Appropriate Dress is mandatory. Gloves, hats and/or ski masks, warm tall socks, snow pants, and jacket are ideal. If your child is not appropriately dressed for the mountain, they will not be permitted to ski/board. The weather gets very cold and windy on the mountain and lift, especially after dark.

Free Lessons are available by trained Greek Peak staff. They are mandatory for 2 weeks for all participants. NO exceptions.

Lessons continue until they achieve the green lift pass. Student will have the ability to test with an instructor if they desire to upgrade their ability card.

New Passes this year:

- RFID cards will be used this year
- They must be in a jacket pocket from chin to knees
- It does not have to be taken out of pocket. Scanners will sense the cards through the outer pocket. (We recommend a lanyard or badge holder attached to a clip on or lanyard).
- When the card is sensed, the light will turn green and gates will open. Photo shows up for lift attendants. (Pictures need to be submitted on the greek peak website)
- Cards are set for day/time you have access to with a few minutes of wiggle room
- Careds can not be near cell phone or will deactivate
- Rentals and meal cards will be separate cards
- They can NOT lose their pass! \$5 to replace.

All participants must ski with a buddy always. They must stay on trails that match their ability tag or lower.

All Virgil students will wear yellow caution tape on arm to help the volunteers identify who is ours on the mountain.

Parent passes are available at a cost. There are also opportunities to volunteer if you are able as well.

I would like to see the end of season Cascades waterpark trip happen again this season. As long as it's open and available, I will be sure it gets set up.

- \$21.60 per person
- There will be no bus for this
- Parents encouraged to join but not required
