#### **DIRECTOR'S UPDATE: Justen Elliott**

**ROC** training attended by Justen and MiYong, Mike, Don and Kim and Steve taught us that the Membership forms we are currently using are not valid. The valid form has been downloaded from the official HOG website and will be distributed for signing.

The online application process also makes the membership forms available on our website

invalid and this process has been removed. We want to make sure that we are protected in case of an event where someone or someone's property is impacted. We must have the HOG form with the membership year and logo and it must contain the wet signature in ink. This is why the electronic forms are not valid. Valid 2026 forms will be distributed and collected. Any questions, please feel free to ask.

Impromptu / last minute pick up rides are acceptable to qualify as a HOG Chapter ride as long as there is a 1 to 1 rider to guest ratio and the number of members must equal or exceed the total number of riders. Take and share photos for posting.

**SECRETARY/MEMBERSHIP: Kim Hidenfelter**

2026 membership forms and dues (\$20) are being collected. Please see Kim to make sure you renew your membership.

**SAFETY OFFICER: Devin Lacasse**

Devin has kindly taken time to put together some safety pointers on riding gear.

**Footwear:** Per riding academy class recommendation, footwear should be over the ankle for support. Soles should be grippy for stopping and shoe/boot should be durable.

Slip and oil resistance helps in the rain and heavy duty material lends added protection in case of an accident.

**Legs:** Chaps/Jean provide protection in the event of a slide and against rain and weather. There is also material which is abrasion resistant. There are riding pants that come with added armour.

**Upper Body:** Jackets are available in abrasion resistant material. Leather provides the most protection. Most jackets now come with pockets that you can add armour to or the jacket comes with added armour.

**Gloves:** Hand protection should be lightweight, abrasion resistant as your hands are the first to hit the pavement in the event of a fall. Waterproof in the inclement weather or cold.

**Head:** Helmets come in so many options. DOT approval is required in the state of Vermont. Full face and modular options provide the most protection. Other helmet options are offered in  $\frac{3}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$  sizes, however; they do not provide much protection. The lifespan of any helmet is 5 years whether it's used a lot or not at all. The inside padding will break down over time and become unprotective. In the event you drop your helmet or it falls to the ground, it should be replaced. Concussions are not fun!

Helmets should be sized correctly to fit the shape and size of your head. Each brand is sized and fits differently. The helmet should be snug but not tight. [Revzilla.com](http://Revzilla.com) has a great video to show you how to select the correctly fitting helmet and if your purchase is not fitting right, they take returns. Whereas, most other helmet vendors DO NOT TAKE returns.

**Eyewear:** Necessary for providing face and eye protection from bugs and road debris. If your bike does not have a windshield then eyewear is required.

**Bike Safety:** Safety checklist: Before each ride check the following:

- First Aid Kit
- Tire Pressure
- No fluid leaks
- Lights are working

**HEAD ROAD CAPTAIN: Jeff Demes****Group Riding**

Ride Leaders should review the 14 point checklist, see Jeff for the checklist.

When coming to a light park on each side of the magnetic strip trigger.

Use the hand signal "Bunch Up" to get everyone through the light.

Ride leaders should carry a sign in sheet, copies of release forms and an Incident Report.

Beware of road snakes and slick spots from fluids on the road.

Be extra careful during rain transition from dry to wet as fluids come to the surface and are slickery.

Be aware of debris and leaves on the road.

**Chapter Ride Etiquette:**

1. You are responsible for your own safety and then help others in need.
2. Traffic lights: advance when safe to proceed.
3. Explain your route and make stops every 1 to 1 and a half hours.

4. Have constructive conversations on issues, don't bark at someone.  
Road Captains lead differently, explain expectations during your introductory speech.  
Safety Tip: Let the tailgaters go by you.

**Next Meeting: Saturday, June 13, 2026. Same time, 6:00pm at Wilkins.**

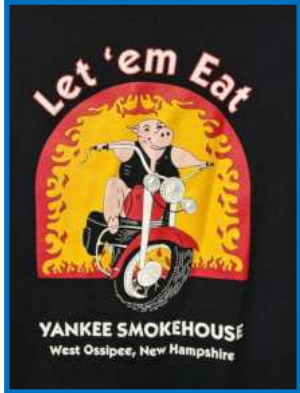

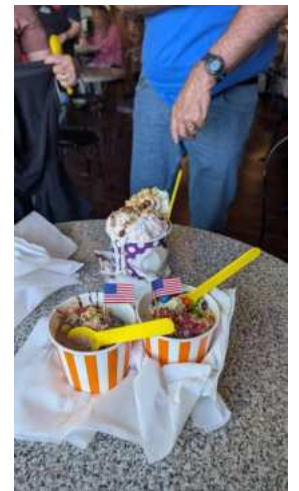

## Central Vermont HOG Chapter Code of Conduct (rev. 3/23/2024)

**Central Vermont H.O.G.** is a family-oriented, non-political, non-religious, non-racial organization. Riding motorcycles while helping each others enjoy *their* riding passion is at our core. Accordingly, we take a very common-sense approach to our members' expected behavior while at a Central Vermont H.O.G. ride, meeting, or event.

1. Treat all other members with respect through a cordial and friendly attitude.
2. Conduct that creates, promotes, or maintains disharmony in the Chapter will not be tolerated.
3. Foul, demeaning or offensive language or behavior at any Central Vermont H.O.G. rides, events or meetings, including at our sponsoring dealership, will not be tolerated.
4. Any form of discrimination or harassment, including but not limited to sexual, racial, or religious, whether direct or indirect, will not be tolerated.
5. Members shall not make critical or disparaging comments about this Chapter or other Chapters, its officers, another member, Wilkins Harley-Davidson or its employees, or the Harley-Davidson motor company in public or on social media.
6. Aggressive behavior towards others, including verbal and/or physical abuse will not be tolerated.

### Breaches of the Code of Conduct

\*Personal disputes/disagreements between members, the dealership, or its employees should be resolved respectfully and discretely.

\*The Chapter director, other officer, or ride leader can speak with the offenders privately, or act as a mediator with the affected and offending parties.

\*Members found to be in violation of any of the above may face potential probation, suspension, or removal from the Chapter.

\*The Sponsoring Dealer or H.O.G. Manager may terminate a person's membership in the Chapter if the Sponsoring Dealer, at their sole discretion, determines that a member's conduct is undesirable or contrary to the Sponsoring Dealer's standards or vision.
