

SKWC Parent Code of Conduct



South Kitsap Wrestling Club seeks to instill positive character-building traits in our communities' youth through the demonstration of good sportsmanship, respect for others, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship. We ask that parents and their guests attending SKWC sponsored events help us by reflecting these character traits at wrestling events

When attending SKWC events and practices, I therefore agree:

- I will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all wrestlers, coaches, officials and spectators at every practice, meet, or tournament.
- I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, wrestler, or parent such as booing, taunting or using profane language or gestures, etc.
- I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and wellbeing of the wrestlers.
- I will teach my child to wrestle by the spirit of the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility, unnecessary roughness, or "cheap-shots".
- I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, religion, sex, or ability.
- I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participant for making a mistake or losing a wrestling match.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during matches and will never confront coaches or referees on the mat. If I have a grievance I will take time to speak with coaches or board members after the event at an agreed upon time and place.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team. I understand I am REQUIRED to be approved by a head coach and have a USA Coaches Card on file to be on the mats.
- I will inform the coach of any physical or learning disability that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning by Official, Head Coach, and/or Board Member.
- Written warning
- Single event suspension
- Entire season suspension
