#### . Why am I using Sunco Green Cannabis Oil?

Sunco Green Cannabis Oil contains the active ingredient extract of Cannabis species containing tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and cannabidiol (CBD). Sunco Green Cannabis Oil may be used to aid in the treatment of a range of conditions including, but not limited to pain, nausea, insomnia, anxiety, anorexia, inflammation, spasticity and seizures.

Do not use if you have ever had an allergic reaction tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and cannabidiol (CBD) or any of the ingredients listed at the end of the CMI.

Talk to your doctor if you have any other medical conditions; if you take any other medicines; or are pregnant or plan to become pregnant or are breastfeeding.

#### Why am I using Sunco Green Cannabis Oil?

Sunco Green Cannabis Oil contains the extracts tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and cannabidiol (CBD) derived from Cannabis which are suspended in MCT oil. The ratio of THC and CBD varies in each different formulation of Sunco Green Cannabis Oil and is clearly stated on the label. CBD and THC have differing effects and have different medical uses.

Sunco Green Cannabis Oil may be used to aid in the treatment of a range of conditions, including, but not limited to:

- · Provide pain relief
- · Provide relief from nausea
- Improve sleep
- Improve anxiety
- Increase appetite
- · Reduce inflammation
- Reduce spasticity
- Reduce occurrence of seizures

The therapeutic benefits of medicinal cannabis may vary depending on a patient's biology and the product selected. This list is not exhaustive. Your doctor will advise you on if medicinal cannabis may be used in your circumstances.

# 2. What should I know before I use Sunco Green Cannabis Oil?

#### Warnings

Do not use Sunco Green Cannabis Oil if:

- You have a history of hypersensitivity or allergy to tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) or cannabidiol (CBD), or any of the ingredients listed at the end of this leaflet.
- You have severe and unstable heart disease (angina, peripheral vascular disease, cerebrovascular disease and arrhythmias) or risk factors for heart disease
- You are pregnant/breastfeeding
- You have unstable or untreated psychiatric conditions, including bipolar disorder, psychosis, or if actively suicidal

Always check the ingredients to make sure you can use this medicine.

Discuss the following with your doctor:

- Any allergies to medicines, food, dyes or preservatives that you may have.
- Any medicines that you are taking, especially other sedatives such as opioids and benzodiazepines.
- Any medicines, supplements, vitamins or preparations that you buy without a prescription from a pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.
- Medicinal cannabis can interact with other medicines, including strong painkillers, medicines used to treat anxiety, depression, epilepsy, aids for sleep, or muscle relaxants. This list is not exhaustive. Speak to your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure if you are taking any of these medications.
- If you are under 25, due to the potentially adverse effects on the developing brain
- If you have severe liver or renal disease
- If you have a history of drug dependence, including nicotine and heavy use of alcohol
- Are elderly or very young as these age groups of patients are likely to be more sensitive to the pharmacological effects of medicinal cannabis

Go to Accident and Emergency at the nearest hospital or call 000 if you notice any of the following:

 Signs of an allergic reaction such as skin rash, itching or hives; swelling of the face, lips or tongue which may cause difficulty in swallowing or breathing, wheezing or shortness of breath

During treatment, you may be at risk of developing certain side effects. It is important you understand these risks and how to monitor for them. See additional information under <u>Section 6</u>. Are there any side effects?

Pregnancy and breastfeeding

Check with your doctor if you are pregnant or intend to become pregnant.

Talk to your doctor if you are breastfeeding or intend to breastfeed.

#### 3. What if I am taking other medicines?

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking any other medicines, including any medicines, vitamins or supplements that you buy without a prescription from your pharmacy, supermarket or health food shop.

There is limited evidence about how medicinal cannabis reacts with other medications. Most interactions are associated with drugs that slow down the nervous system such as sedatives, benzodiazepines, and hypnotics.

Other drug interactions may include:

- Anti-depressants (Fluoxetine, Fluvoxamine)
- Anti-coagulants (Warfarin, Apixaban, Rivaroxaban)
- Antiretroviral drugs used in the treatment of HIV/AIDS
- Stomach acid inhibitors (Omeprazole)
- Certain antibiotic and antifungal medications
- Some heart medications (Amiodarone, Diltiazem, Verapamil)
- Some anti-epileptic medications (*Carbamazepine, Phenytoin, Clobazam*)
- · St John's Wort.

Check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure about what medicines, vitamins or supplements you are taking and if these interact with Sunco Green Cannabis Oil

#### 4. How do I use Sunco Green Cannabis Oil?

How much and when to take / use Sunco Green Cannabis Oil

- Always follow the directions of your doctor regarding how much and how often you should use Sunco Green Cannabis Oil.
- Follow instructions provided. Use Sunco Green Cannabis Oil until your doctor tells you to stop.

Directions for Use

Sunco Green Cannabis Oil Bottles are supplied with a bottle adaptor and syringe.

Please follow these steps for correct dosing and administration.

 Remove the bottle cap. If this is your first use, insert the clear bottle adaptor with the small hole in the center, into the bottle.




 Insert the tip of the syringe into the bottle adaptor and press down until it is snug. Invert the bottle so that the top of the bottle with the attached syringe is facing downward.



Draw up the prescribed volume into the syringe by pulling back the plunger so that the black line aligns with the dose.



4. Turn the bottle upright and remove the syringe by pulling up on the barrel (not the plunger).



Aim the tip of the syringe into the mouth and depress the plunger into the barrel. Swallow the dose.



 To wash the syringe, separate the plunger from the barrel and wash with warm water. Allow it to dry completely before the next dose



If you forget to use Sunco Green Cannabis Oil

- Sunco Green Cannabis Oil should be used regularly at the same time each day. If you miss your dose at the usual time, talk to your doctor or pharmacist about the most appropriate time to take the missed dose.
- If you miss your dose at the usual time and it is almost time for your next dose, skip the dose you missed and take your next dose when you are meant to.
- Do not take a double dose to make up for the dose you missed.

If you use too much Sunco Green Cannabis Oil

- If you experience symptoms of anxiety, nausea, dizziness, vomiting, or fainting, it is important that you don't panic.
- You should focus on your breathing, stay hydrated, and find a safe place to relax.
- The effects should wear off in 2-6 hours, depending on the method of consumption.
- If health and safety become a concern, contact your doctor immediately.
- Should you experience chest pain, persistent vomiting, or dizziness causing falls, you should go to Accident and Emergency at the nearest hospital or call 000 immediately.

If you think that you have used too much Sunco Green Cannabis Oil, you may need urgent medical attention.

You should immediately:

- phone the Poisons Information Centre (by calling 13 11 26), or
- · contact your doctor, or
- go to the Emergency Department at your nearest hospital.

You should do this even if there are no signs of discomfort or poisoning.

# 5. What should I know while using Sunco Green Cannabis Oil?

#### Things you should do

Tell your doctor that you are taking Sunco Green Cannabis Oil:

- · Before starting any new medicine
- · If you become pregnant
- If you plan to have surgery, including dental surgery
- If you are about to have any blood tests

Talk to your doctor about your treatment. If your condition is worsening while on Sunco Green Cannabis Oil, you should notify your doctor.

#### Things you should not do

- Do not vaporize Sunco Green Cannabis Oil. The oil is strictly for oral consumption.
- Do not stop taking your medicine suddenly.
   Always speak to your pharmacist or doctor before stopping any medicine.

#### Driving or using machines

You should not drive or operate machinery while being treated with Sunco Green Cannabis Oil. Measurable concentrations of THC can be detected many days after the last dose. It may take up to 5 days for 80-90% of the THC to be excreted. Drugdriving is a criminal offence. You should discuss the implications for safe and legal driving with your doctor.

#### Drinking alcohol

Tell your doctor if you drink alcohol.

Do not consume Sunco Green Cannabis Oil and alcohol at the same time their effects may magnify each other's, causing discomfort and inebriation.

#### Looking after your medicine

- Store below 25 degrees Celsius in a cool dry place away from moisture, heat or sunlight
- Sunco Green Cannabis Oil does not need to be refrigerated

Do not store your medicine:

- · In the bathroom or near a sink, or
- · In the car or on a windowsill
- KEEP IT OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN

#### Getting rid of any unwanted medicine

- If you no longer need to use this medicine or it is out of date, take it to any pharmacy for safe disposal.
- · Do not use this medicine after the expiry date.

#### 6. Are there any side effects?

All medicines, including medicinal cannabis, can have side effects. The extent of these may vary with the type of medicinal cannabis product and between individuals.
