SHUTTLE BUSES:

North Branford Poco Festival offers \$2 round trip shuttle services to and from the event!

Northford Side:

Shuttle buses will pick up at Stanley T. Williams Community Center at 1332 Middletown Ave, Northford CT. ADA Shuttle - (Top of the Hour) Available at STW ONLY

North Branford Side:

Shuttle buses will pick up at North Branford Intermediate School 654 Foxon Road (RT80), North Branford, CT. AND

North Branford High School 49 Caputo Rd. North Branford, CT.

Note no shuttles will be available at Jerome Harrison
Elementary School

PARKING:

\$25 onsite general parking will be located at Augur Valley entrance at 641 Totoket Road. Please refer to the parking map for exact directions from I-91N, I-91S, or I-95N.

\$25 Handicap parking will be located at the main festival entrance 290 Forest Rd (Rt 22). Valid handicap parking permits will be required to be displayed. Handicap parking is on a first come basis.

STUDENT DROP OFF / PICKUP:

The designated student drop off/pick up will be at the Augur House on Forest Rd (Rt 22). The entrance is located just north of the main entrance traveling north on Rt. 22. For everyone's safety and to help the flow of traffic, student drop off/pick up WILL NOT be allowed in the shuttle bus area of the main

POCO FESTIVAL FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

1. HOW MUCH IS THE ENTRANCE FEE?

A. There is no entrance fee. The entire event and all entertainment is free. However, the food, craft and business vendors throughout the weekend charge for their product. **On-site parking fee is \$25**

2. IF IT RAINS, IS THERE A RAIN DATE?

A. *This event is held rain or shine.* There is no rain date. The only rain date is for the Fireworks scheduled for Saturday night. The rain date for fireworks only is Sun., Aug. 4 at approximately 9:15 pm. - I'll check the vendor forms but I am pretty sure they all say they have to stay too if fireworks move to Sunday.

3. ARE PETS ALLOWED?

A. Only service animals are allowed on the Festival grounds. Pets are not otherwise permitted.

4. IS THERE HANDICAPPED PARKING?

A. There is limited handicapped parking at 290 Forest Rd. You must have a valid handicap placard displayed. There is a \$25 parking fee. ADA shuttles are available from STW Community Center

5. IS THERE PARKING ON-SITE?

A. There is ample parking available at Augur Valley - 641 Totoket Rd. On-site parking is \$25.00 cash only. Money generated from our festival goes back to the community and Student Athletes. There is also designated motorcycle parking available.

6. ARE THERE DIRECTIONS AVAILABLE?

A. Directions can be found under the information tab on our website. Please use 641 Totoket Road, Northford, CT for GPS directions for general parking.

7. WHAT ABOUT THE FANTASTIC FIREWORKS I KEEP HEARING SO MUCH ABOUT?

A. The firework show begins after 9pm. on Saturday night. In the event of inclement weather, the fireworks show will be postponed to Sunday night around 9pm. The information will be posted on this website.

8. HOW CAN I GET REAL-TIME INFORMATION REGARDING THIS EVENT?

A. Both our website, Instagram, and Facebook page are updated throughout the weekend with details on weather, cancellations, and other information. We STRONGLY encourage you to "like" our Facebook page. (North-Branford-Potato-and-Corn-Festival) in order to receive information as opposed to phoning the Recreation Department which has limited hours over the weekend. You can also follow us on Facebook &

Instagram.

9. CAN WE BRING IN OUR OWN FOOD/DRINK/COOLERS? A. NO coolers, outside food, or drinks are allowed.

- 10. Please, NO DRONES! They are extremely dangerous with the large crowds we expect.
- 11. We offer \$2 shuttles to and from the event. One lot in Northford and Two lots in North Branford. Check our online site for specific locations.
- 12. Parent drop off and pick is located at the Augur House, 298 Forest Rd.

13. WHERE DOES THE MONEY EARNED BY THE FESTIVAL GO?

A. We are a committee made up of Volunteers and the Festival itself is self-sustaining. The NET PROCEEDS from the festival provide the teams sports incentives, Scholarships, local organization donations, supporting a holiday dinner for the NB Senior Center, and to fund the following year's festival. We take pride in a free festival, free transportation, and free shuttles.

14. DO YOU NEED CASH?

A. We have ATMs on-site and most vendors accept credit/debit cards.

15. HOW DOES THE WRISTBAND WORK FOR RIDES?

A. We offer discounted wristbands online until July 26th. You are able to continue to purchase full price wristbands all the way through the weekend online to save time standing in line during the festival.

The Fiesta Shows Amusement Company offers weekend, one day, and individual tickets on-site. The fees are not set by the festival. Full-weekend wristbands are valid for the entirety of the festival.

GENERAL ON-SITE PARKING - \$25 641 Totoket Road, Northford, CT

From 195 North or South:

Take exit 55 and head East on Rt 1 towards Guilford. Take a Left on to N Branford Rd./Rt 139, bringing you to the intersection of Rt80. Take a left onto Rt80 and follow signs. All general parking is located at 641 Totoket road.

From - 191 South

Take exit 14 and turn right off the exit and first left on S Airline Rd. Continue until next traffic light turn left onto Woodhouse Ave./Rt 150, follow until stop sign and turn left, continue until you see signs for poco festival. Please expect traffic delays!
