

Payment Terms and Conditions:

Missed classes have to be paid for

- If a student misses a lesson they can make this up on another day or in another style as long as the class is the same age group (or ballet grade)
- If a student ceases dance lessons ongoing fees are still payable if the parent/guardian does not inform BWDance.

How to pay?

1. Paying by the week:

- Can be paid as cash or via bank deposit (preferred). Please try to have the correct change labelled envelopes are also definitely appreciated ⁽²⁾
- An admin fee of **\$10 per term** will apply to students who pay weekly, fortnightly or monthly.
- All monies received will be put towards outstanding fees first and then costume deposits.
- A late fee of **\$15 per week** will apply to fees overdue by 14 days.
- If payment is still not received after 21 days (3 weeks) BWDance reserves the right to refuse service.
- Overdue accounts of more than 60 days duration will be referred to a collection agency.

2. Paying by the term:

• There will be a 10% early bird discount on term payments if paid in full within 2 weeks of invoice date

Potential Additional Costs:

1. Uniform:

Different dance styles may require different shoes or dance tights. If you are participating in multiple dance styles you will be expected to have all required footwear and uniform.

2. Costumes (For students doing the end of year concert)

At the end of year there is an annual dance concert. Each dance class will perform a group dance. A costume will need to be purchased for each dance a student performs in - we will advise specific costs (usually \$55 - \$75).

3. Term Costume Deposits (For students doing the end of year concert)

To facilitate gradually paying off costumes there is a compulsory deposit of <u>\$15 per costume</u> required at the beginning of each term. This means at the end of the year most of the costumes will be already paid off.

4. Stage Rehearsal Fee (For students doing the end of year concert)

This \$25 fee helps to cover the cost of venue hire, music licensing, Laycock theatre staff, insurance, sound and lighting and administration fees associated with the stage rehearsal.
