## Yearbooks (Shutterfly Contact - Mandy)

### Key Tips and Things To Remember:

1. **Yearbook and Bulk orders are a “Two Order Process”** - Bulk and Yearbook ordering is a three-step process that requires two separate orders via the Shutterfly website. I just wanted to make sure that you don't forget to place the second order for the books, otherwise our production teams won't ever start on your project which could cause it to be late.
  - a. You can start creating your book at any time. [Click Here to start a Photo Book](#).
  - b. The second step is to prepay for your books. This will charge your credit card and issue credits into your account. [Click Here to prepay](#).
  - c. The final step is to place an order for your completed project on the Shutterfly website. This order should be for \$0.00 but will insert your order into manufacturing schedule. [Click Here to Order](#)
2. **Quotes are specific to the amounts and features selected** - I have included the specifics of your quote again below in this email, you can certainly change this if you find you need a different amount or want to change the features of your book. The best way to do that is just to submit a new quote through the very same process. The quoted amounts are guaranteed for at least 60 days so you have plenty of time finalize your book before pre-paying for it.
3. **Proofing Bulk and Yearbook Orders is very important** – Please allow extra time to have someone from your organization proofread your project before ordering. Replacements or refunds for typos and other project creation errors will not be issued.
  - a. Remember to check all names and captions carefully
  - b. Remember to check all dates and event titles carefully
  - c. Remember to check all resolution errors that might be displayed projects
2. **Economy Shipping will be free for Bulk and Yearbook orders** – Faster shipping speeds may be available but cannot be guaranteed by the date reflected in the shopping cart and these will add to the cost of the original quote.
  - a. The actual delivery dates will be determined when you place your 'Production Order'
  - b. There is a two week production time for all bulk and yearbook orders
  - c. Please note that if you pay to upgrade your shipping speed, the delivery date quoted in the cart will not be guaranteed
2. **International ordering and check payments are not available** – Please make sure you are able to pay with a credit card and have a delivery address within the United States before committing to creating and ordering your project.
3. **Tax Exempt Orders require additional time to arrange** - If you will be placing this order for a tax exempt organization you will need to make sure your account is set up to remove tax at the time of purchase. This only needs to be done once but can take up to 7 days to coordinate so make sure you allow for this additional time if this is your first tax exempt order.
  - a. Taxes cannot be refunded after purchase so I want to make sure to help you get this taken care of as early as possible
  - b. Tax Exempt orders cannot be placed from personal accounts but your quoted amount will apply to any account you use to place your order
