Re: Spring Performance Trip to Bandera, TX

The TMHS Wildcat Choir Program will travel to San Antonio and Bandera, TX for their Spring Trip this year! This trip is open to all choir students and parents. Limited to 100 participants, so please register your deposit and contract early!

TENTATIVE DATES: Leave Thursday, May 1st, 2025 after school and return Sunday evening on May 4th, 2025

WHO: All eligible Choir Students. Eligibility is determined by <u>grades for the prior 9-nine weeks report card, behavior record and daily and concert attendance.</u> Specifically, students must meet the following requirements:

- All grades on the third nine-weeks report card must be 70 or above;
- All grades at the last UIL eligibility period before the trip must be 70 or above;
- Must not have been assigned ISS for more than 2 days, been assigned OSS, or placed at DAEP at any time in the 24-25 school year;
- Must not have more than 10 absences (excused and/or unexcused) from school; and
- Must not have any unexcused absences from a concert or other required choir activity/event.
- All students are subject to the TISD Student Code of Conduct while on the trip. Misconduct on the trip
 may result in disciplinary consequences in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct and/or
 requirement for the parent to immediately pick up the student from the trip location.

COST: Approximately \$750+ per student quad before fund-raising. \$800+ per adult double room. This includes: 3 nights lodging in a hotel/Dude Ranch, charter bus service, Six Flags Fiesta ticket, Tower of Americas Dinner, Flying L Hill Dude Ranch, and more.

If your child is planning to go on the spring trip, we will need a trip deposit of \$100 along with the form below by **Sunday, September 15, 2024** to secure a spot for your child on the trip. Trip contracts must be signed and turned into Mr. Ragsdale or Ms. White in person. No digital copies will be accepted. A payment schedule for the rest of the trip follows. Please be aware that the **deposit is non-refundable** and monies paid for the rest of the trip cannot be refunded after the December 15th payment. UNDER TEXAS STATE LAW, STUDENTS WHO ARE FAILING ANY CLASS MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES so be aware that if your student becomes ineligible due to academics, attendance, or behavior prior to the trip, we will not be able to refund any trip payments. If your student loses the ability to go on the trip, the trip must be sold to another student for a full or partial refund, but if the trip cannot sell, the trip must still be paid in full. Again, if a student decides not to go on the trip for any other reason, they will not receive a refund unless you are able to sell the trip.

Those interested in going on the trip should return the trip contract and pay a **NON-REFUNDABLE \$100.00 deposit by Sept 15, 2024.** Trip deposits will not be accepted without the completed trip contract signed and turned in. All payments through schoolcashonline will have a processing fee included. Further payments will be made online as follows:
