The City Council of the City of Vienna met in regular session, Wednesday, June 17, 2026 at Vienna City Hall with the following members and guests:

There being a quorum, Mayor Penrod called the meeting of the Vienna City Council to order at 6:30 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

Alderman Hill made a motion to Authorize and Approve the Omnibus Consent Agenda consisting of June 3, 2026 Meeting Minutes, May Treasurer Report and the Warrant (\$70,802.34). Alderman Tuey seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Mayor Penrod gave information on the city applying for a Delta Regional Authority (DRA) Grant in place of the previously discussed Rural Development Grant for sewer infrastructure, as it may provide a greater funding opportunity.

Alderman Moore made a motion to Authorize and Approve Resolution 26-06, A Resolution to commit local funds and apply for a grant to complete a basic public infrastructure project within the City of Vienna. The motion was seconded by Alderman Racey. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Tuey made a motion to Authorize and Approve to extend a Contractual Agreement for the Provision of Transportation Services, between Shawnee Mass Transit and the City of Vienna in the amount of \$3,000.00 (July-Dec, 2026). The motion was seconded by Alderman Moore. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Hill made a motion to Authorize and Approve Liquor License Application for a Class D license submitted by Tio's Taqueria, 502 West Vine St. Alderman Racey seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Public comment was made by Brian Carey regarding grant funding opportunities.

ELECTED/APPOINTED OFFICIALS

Alderman Elliott commented on the newly installed lighted USA sign along 146 W. Elliott also said parking issues in this area will need to be addressed following completion of highway projects. Additionally, he mentioned possible demolition of the old restroom building located in the city park, noting it was no longer in use.

Alderman Moore suggested converting Galeener Street into a one-way street entering from College St. due to traffic issues. Council briefly discussed.

Alderman Tuey mentioned contacting VHS to see if the shop class would possibly assist refurbishing barbeque grills at the city park as several were in poor condition. Tuey also inquired on the status of food vendors for the fireworks event.

Mayor Penrod discussed replacement of spring horse riders at the city park and the possibility of funding assistance from Arrowleaf. Council discussed reaching out to Modern Woodmen as well for funding.

Penrod discussed maintenance to be performed on the pedestrian bridge at the city park, noting it would be painted. Penrod said the broadcasting booth at the ballpark would be renovated by the Shawnee College construction crew class.

Penrod reported he met with IDOT regarding dilapidated buildings on N. 4th/Vine saying there was no counter offer submitted to IDOT by one of the property owners.

As there was no further business to discuss, Alderman Racey made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Alderman Tuey. Mayor Penrod declared the meeting adjourned at 7:11 p.m.
