There being a quorum, Mayor Penrod called the meeting of the Vienna City Council to order at 6:30 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

Alderman Hill made a motion to Authorize and Approve the Omnibus Consent Agenda consisting of June 17, 2026 Meeting Minutes and the Warrant (\$38,750.41). Alderman Tuey seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Richard Howell, Horner & Shifrin was present to review a change order and payment requests for water improvement contracts.

Alderman Tuey made a motion to Authorize and Approve Change order #2, Contract A-Watermain Improvements \$10,500.00. Alderman Moore seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Elliott made a motion to Authorize and Approve payment request in the amount of \$58,147.09 from Bryant Construction (Contract A). The motion was seconded by Alderman Hill. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Moore made a motion to Authorize and Approve payment request in the amount of \$26,885.00 from Elevation Coatings & Restoration (Contract B). Alderman Racey seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Racey made a motion to Authorize and Approve Engineering Fees in the amount of \$43,181.95 from Horner & Shifrin- Inv#80522. The motion was seconded by Alderman Tuey. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Racey made a motion to Authorize and Approve proposal from Horner & Shifrin to provide professional engineering services for Veterans Avenue sewer extension. Alderman Hill seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

Council reviewed an application for TIF assistance submitted by Morgan Norris with Glow Studio, 102 North 1st St. Norris was present to answer questions. Alderman Moore made a motion to Approve project funding in the amount of a 40% reimbursement rate with a limit of \$17,500.00. Alderman Elliott seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Hill-aye, Moore-aye, Elliott-aye, Pitts-aye, Racey-abstain (relation to applicant), Tuey-aye. Motion carried.

Alderman Hill made a motion to Authorize and Approve the purchase of a 2026-CID X Root Grapple from C&K Auto in the amount of \$4,950.00 (split funds: General Streets/Gas/Water). Alderman Tuey seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Alderman Moore mentioned concern of a dilapidated property. Brief discussion was had over neglected yards, the current ordinance and penalties.

Alderman Tuey mentioned holding a fall festival parade committee meeting to discuss details including parade theme and grand marshal.

Alderman Racey expressed concerns about conditions of North Fourth and North Sixth Street following recent waterline project work. Racey noted holes that need to be filled and questioned who is responsible.

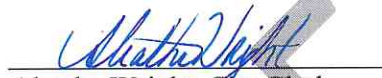
Alderman Hill said she had contacted someone from the Vienna Correctional Center and was informed the recycling program is not expected to be re-established.

Mayor-Pro Tem Pitts said the city was contacted by an individual requesting permission to paraglide over the ballfields prior to the fireworks display. He contacted Chief Williams regarding the request and said it was approved, contingent on weather conditions.

As there was no further business to discuss, Alderman Racey made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Alderman Moore. Mayor Penrod declared the meeting adjourned at 7:09 p.m.
