Resolution 26- 08

RESOLVED September 16, 2026

WHEREAS: Choate Mental Health and Developmental Center in Anna serves a vital function in the Illinois Department of Human Services' system of care for individuals with severe developmental disabilities and mental illness, including those who have been found not guilty by reason of insanity or unfit to stand trial in criminal cases; and

WHEREAS: For many of these individuals, Choate is the only suitable place in Southern Illinois that can care for them and meet their needs; and **WHEREAS:** Choate is an important source of good jobs and meaningful work in Southern Illinois, employing over 450 people at the facility; and

WHEREAS: IDHS commissioned a study with SIU School of Medicine, which on July 14, 2023, issued the Choate Transformation Plan that called for an expansion of services on the Choate campus; and

WHEREAS: Choate employees have long advocated for improved funding, staffing and training opportunities recommended in the SIU study to better meet the needs of residents, while the Illinois Department of Human Services instead has transferred a number of residents to other developmental centers elsewhere in the state where they have struggled to adjust to these new settings; and

WHEREAS: In July 2026, DHS announced plans to further slash services at Choate and lay off some 250 staff at the facility; and **WHEREAS:** DHS has also announced that the treatment program provided on the "stepdown" unit that serves individuals with mental illness who are ending their term of confinement mandated by the courts will be moved to Madden Mental Health Center in the Chicago metro area, which is not equipped to serve such a population; and

WHEREAS: Such a drastic cut to mental health services available in Southern Illinois would profoundly affect the availability and quality of care for vulnerable City of Vienna residents; and

WHEREAS: City of Vienna residents in need of such care for severe mental illness and developmental disabilities would be forced to seek care further away from family, friends, and support systems;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Vienna, Illinois

That the City Council of the City of Vienna, Illinois urges the Illinois Department of Human Services to reverse its decision to drastically downsize Choate Mental Health and Developmental Center; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED: That the City Council of the City of Vienna, Illinois urges the State of Illinois to reverse the trend of divestment in mental health services available to Southern Illinois residents.

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN ILLINOIS TRANSPORTATION
ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM (ITEP) GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE US
ROUTE 45 PEDESTRIAN/BIKE TRAIL PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Vienna, located in Johnson County, State of Illinois, desires to participate in the development and construction of streetscape and related pedestrian improvements along US Route 45 (the "Project") to improve the safety, accessibility, and functionality of the transportation corridor and enhance pedestrian and non-motorized transportation within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vienna has determined that the proposed Project will provide transportation and community benefits and is consistent with the City's goals for improving its transportation infrastructure, pedestrian environment, and community streetscape; and

WHEREAS, an Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) Grant may fund 90% of eligible preliminary engineering, design, construction, and construction engineering costs and 50% of eligible right-of-way and street lighting costs of the proposed improvements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Vienna, Johnson County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into, and made part of, this Resolution.

SECTION 2: The City of Vienna does hereby commit to being responsible for payment of any required matching funds and/or ineligible or other costs associated with the US ROUTE 45 PEDESTRIAN/BIKE TRAIL PROJECT as determined by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

SECTION 3: The City Mayor and/or his or her designee is hereby authorized to execute such applications, agreements, certifications, and other documents as may be necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes of this Resolution and the Project.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
