City Council Proclamation
Sexual Assault Awareness Month –
April 2026

WHEREAS, sexual violence is a serious and pervasive problem that affects individuals of every age, gender, race, and socioeconomic background, and someone in the United States is sexually assaulted nearly every minute; and

WHEREAS, sexual assault and other forms of sexual violence have lasting physical, emotional, and psychological impacts on survivors and deeply affect families, communities, and society as a whole; and

WHEREAS, we recognize the strength, courage, and resilience of survivors and affirm our commitment to supporting them, believing them, and ensuring they have access to compassionate services, support, advocacy, and justice; and

WHEREAS, prevention is possible through education, community awareness, and by fostering a culture of respect, accountability, and consent; and

WHEREAS, communities play a critical role in ending sexual violence by speaking out against harmful attitudes and behaviors, supporting prevention efforts, and holding those who commit acts of violence accountable; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of all community members, organizations, educators, and leaders to work together to promote safety, dignity, and respect for every individual; and

WHEREAS, the theme for Sexual Assault Awareness Month 2026, “25 Years Stronger: Looking Back, Moving Forward,” invites communities across the nation to reflect on the progress made by survivors and advocates while recommitting to building a future free from sexual violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the City of Vienna, IL on behalf of the residents of Vienna hereby proclaims the month of April 2026 as Sexual Assault Awareness Month in Vienna.
