With proceeds from last year's fundraisers, our Pi Phi chapter purchased the full set of 2004-2005 Bluebonnet books for the shelter. The library was created by a Grapevine High School

(GHS) student, Katy Copeland, who is earning her Girl Scout Gold Award, which is similar to an Eagle Scout Award. One of our members, Cathy Morris, a GHS teacher, learned of Katy's project and volunteered Pi Phi's assistance. By donating the books, we have helped our community in two ways:
