Overcrowding at animal shelters isn't uncommon, but this summer has been worse than usual.

Our capacity is normally 200 cats. This summer, Focus on Ferals has been at capacity and above. We currently have 332 cats. A year ago, we averaged 257 cats in August. All of our foster homes and foster facilities are full!

We do not like to turn away animals, but, unless it is an emergency, we have no alternative, we don't have room available. If you need help with an abandoned or stray cat or kitten, please provide them with food, water and shelter, and contact us. We will put you on a waiting list. As our numbers come down, we will be able to help. If you need food, please let us know, and we will make it available to you.
