LEASING NEW VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

A brief discussion was initiated by Chief Wilfong regarding the interest rates received from Bank of Crocker, Bank of Missouri and Maries County Bank regarding leasing 3 new Dodge Durangos, completely equipped. As instructed, he contacted three local banks and requested lower interest rates for \$176,700.00. Chief Wilfong indicated that the Bank of Crocker did not want anything to do with the lease. Bank of Missouri offered 5 years at 5.5% interest rate and Maries County Bank offered 4 years at 6% interest rate. Chief Wilfong indicated that accepting the Maries County Bank offer would save the City \$12,000.00 vs Bank of Missouri. Council instructed Chief Wilfong to get with Kelli, City Clerk, to crunch the numbers.



ORDINANCE FOR PUBLIC INTOXICATION

A brief discussion was held regarding a new ordinance for public intoxication. Katy indicated that the City has an ordinance for disorderly conduct that would cover that nuisance. One concern was intoxicated while performing a misdemeanor, such as stealing. Katy informed if it's a 4th offense, refer the individual to the state for felony charges.
