4. INVOCATION  
No invocation was given.
5. ADOPT THE AGENDA  
Stacey Yoakum made a motion to adopt the agenda with the addition of the McLiney Municipal Advisory Agreement and correcting the minutes date to January 9, 2023. Mary Wiles seconded the motion. Roll call to vote: Stacey Yoakum, Mary Wiles, Wesley Wilfong, Anthony Campbell

6. APPROVE JANUARY 9, 2023 MINUTES  
Stacey Yoakum made the motion to approve the minutes of January 9, 2023, Wesley Wilfong seconded the motion. Roll call to vote: Stacey Yoakum, Mary Wiles, Wesley Wilfong, Anthony Campbell (abstained)  
Motion tabled 3-0, 1 abstention
7. MCLINEY MUNICIPAL ADVISORY AGREEMENT  
Ed McLiney presented the agreement to the council. The agreement is on a contingency basis. If the bond is not approved, we do not owe the company anything. Stacey Yoakum made a motion to enter into an agreement with McLiney and Company. Motion was

8. WWTP BOND APRIL BALLOT

Jeff Medows from Archer Elgin spoke regarding the issues the City of Dixon is facing at the WWTP. Eight million dollars has been identified as needed to repair the WWTP to be in compliance. There are three primary concerns that will cost approximately \$6.25 Million to get into compliance; 1) sludge handling, 2) disinfection which needs to be completed by 2025, and 3) peak flows into the system. This figure does not include three concerns that are not priority but that need to be addressed or they will become an issue down the road; 1) influent removal, 2) secondary clarifier mechanism, and 3) waste sludge system. The City will be requesting SRF funds of \$3M and CDG funds of \$750,000. If the bond is not passed we will not be eligible to apply for the SRF.

McLiney made clear to the Council that if a bond is approved for say \$8M that doesn't mean \$8M will be spent. An approved bond means we are allowed to use the money as needed and the remaining balance will be available for years to come. McLiney also informed the council that the City of Dixon has \$2.5M remaining in unclaimed bond money.

City Clerk, Deanna Burns, mentioned that we have \$442,000 in ARPA funds remaining. Motion for approval of a bond in the amount of \$5M to upgrade the sewer system was made by Anthony Campbell, Mary Wiles seconded the motion. Roll call to vote: Stacey Yoakum, Mary Wiles, Wesley Wilfong, Anthony Campbell  
Motion carried 4-0
