Kelli Livengood reported 2024 year end information has been completed and filed appropriately. Missouri State Highway Patrol has a truck we are looking to purchase with ARPA funds. It is equipped with the full light package. Saint James Auto has a truck that we are looking to purchase with ARPA money and insurance money from the wrecked

truck. Council agreed on the police truck but would like public works to look for more options.

#### 16. POLICE UPDATE

Chief Wilfong performed the swearing in of new Assistant Chief, Randy Cottner. Plans are to hire a dispatcher/office manager in the near future. Officer Vermulm is our reserve and we are currently looking for additional reserve officers. Crime rates, drug traffic and calls for service are down. MULES training is upcoming. Our focus is proactive policing.

#### 17. PUBLIC WORKS UPDATE

Nathan Cox reported a total completion of 25 work orders for the month of December with one water leak that required a boil advisory. Total Water loss for December was 16%. Water analysis for December showed 4,150,000 gallons of water pumped/accounted for, 800,000 gallons lost and 3,400,000 gallons of water sold. WWTF had 5,500,000 gallons treated in December. The Public Works crew has been plowing and salting roads. A Level 2 Assessment is being conducted by DNR due to failed samples collected at residences.
