We grow native species plants organically from seed and cuttings. Our program is adaptable and hours are flexible to accommodate your schedule. Required are 72 hours of your time after school or on weekends. Your school can give you a credit for your effort, as work experience. An **\$800.00 stipend** will be awarded by **Friends of Bandon Parks & Recreation** *upon completion* of this internship.

The following apply specifically to the nursery and horticultural industry as well as habitat restorations.

Interns will:

- Be willing to get dirty, maybe get wet, and work outdoors
- Be on time and follow directions closely
- Work well with others and also to be comfortable working independently
- Be able to lift 35 lbs and walk on uneven terrain
- Tolerate an outdoor work environment. Exposure to indoor and outdoor environmental conditions, including extreme temperature fluctuations, rain, dust, allergens, insects, and sun exposure.

Main duties will be starting seeds, mixing custom potting soil, transplanting trees and shrubs, creating habitat on public land or around nursery. We work in the greenhouse when weather is rainy and absences can be made up with written assignments.

Apply now! South Coast high school students can get hands on experience and earn a high school credit as a nursery intern at Stillwater Natives Nursery and Bandon. The Friends of Bandon Parks and Recreation, a non-profit 501c3 organization and

Stillwater Natives are collaborating for a second year, offering internships to students 16 years or older. Darcy Grahek, nursery owner, will assist students gain experience with the organic growing of native nursery plants. This year's program runs from February 10 through June 2, taking the same breaks as the schools. A second session for two new interns begins next September. Local High School students receive a work credit from their school for the semester. A stipend of \$800 is provided by Friends of Bandon Parks and Rec. upon completion of the internship.
