Engineered Wood Fiber

Economical playground surfacing that is used in many playgrounds spaces. It absorbs impact from falls, slip resistant surface.

After review of multiple surface options by City staff and Park and Rec Committee, engineered wood was preferred because of its ease of installation, product cost, durability, and safety.

The next step is to find a cost-effective way to removed tire chips and find a distributor of engineered wood chips.

- 6. Engineered wood found to be best option given budget, our climate conditions.




