

CRYSTAL SPRINGS DISC GOLF COURSE - FAIRBURY, NE

OVERVIEW

The second project of the Elpison Foundation flows away from tournaments and towards course design and installation. The Elpison Foundation exists to elevate the current standard of disc golf in Nebraska while simultaneously giving back to the communities that make it possible for us to do so. As a part of this mission, the Elpison Foundation will be installing a new disc golf course at Crystal Springs Campground in Fairbury, Nebraska in 2023. Our goal is to create an elite-level disc golf course that can host the Nebraska State Championships and other highly competitive tournaments on an annual basis. We expect these tournaments to bring in nearly 90 people from four to five states each year. The course is being designed with tournament play in mind. This has allowed the Elpison Foundation to use the land at Crystal Springs in a manner that embraces length, score separation, and shot shapes.

In addition to these tournaments, we anticipate this course engaging many members of the Fairbury community and offering another great form of exercise in the area. The McNish Disc Golf Course has proved to be a great addition to our community, and we are excited to see how the sport of disc golf and the Elpison Foundation can continue to push Fairbury forward.
