# First Day of School

The 2018-2019 school year will commence on Tuesday, September 4<sup>th</sup> and will be a half-day for all students. We begin at 9:30 AM and are finished by 11:30 AM. Kindergarten to Grade 6 students should report to the elementary building, while those in Grades 7 through 12 should report to classrooms H1 and H2 in the high school. **Students should be in uniform dress code on this day.** 

## **Regular School Hours**

Regular school hours are 8:55 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Doors open for students at 8:20 a.m. The school is closed after 4:10 p.m. to allow for staff planning and janitorial service. Students should be picked up as close to 3:00 p.m. as possible, except in the event of extracurricular activities or homework room.

# School Supplies
