

To All Kindergarten – Grades 3 Parents,

We greatly appreciate the enthusiasm we have seen from the parents and are excited to have you join us on our field trips throughout the school year! Please consider the following expectations and requirements listed below when you volunteer as a driver and supervisor for our upcoming events.

All supervisors should be able to:

- safely transport groups of 2-5 students in your vehicles and ensure each student is in a booster seat
- avoid purchasing any food or drinks to/from the sites, and for the duration of the entire field trip
- strictly refrain from using your cell phone while driving (this includes texting or making calls with a 'hands-free' system)
- employ leadership skills in guiding groups around the facilities
- prepare to give reminders to students about waiting patiently for their turns, being mindful of their volume, and demonstrating good manners
- make separate arrangements for younger siblings to be taken care of by a sitter or family member (to allow students to bond with their own classmates and get to know the other parents of the class)

*\*\*Please notify the teacher if there are concerns or incidents with any of the students. It is important for us to know right away so we can address issues/problems immediately in order to help use these experiences for learning.*

We aim to provide safe and nurturing experiences for our students, so we hope that everyone will be able to adhere to these standards. We also invite parents to volunteer for a minimum of one trip a year and a maximum of three trips. This would help us evenly distribute opportunities and responsibilities among our wonderful class parents. Your efforts and consideration are greatly appreciated.
