Introduction:

This program was designed to accommodate multiple issues we face as a charitable organization. Given that we are unsure of how the rest of the world manages their charitable organizations we assume that the Biker Community may have more pessimistic elements than non-biker community based charities. None the less, we love our biker community and in a sense appreciate the scrutiny. We hope that all charities are scrutinized to the extent that they produce the degree of public disclosure we do.

Because we were once uneducated in the technical legalities of charitable organizations we certainly are not going to judge those who may be as ignorant as we were on this matter. What we will do is attempt to satisfy curiosity and scrutiny by educating our followers in a public and transparent forum such as we are doing by publishing this program right now.

There are in fact several bogus charities out there, we've been able to identify them because of our understanding. 'Bogus' does not necessarily mean 'fraudulent', but it does mean "maybe". It is not our purpose to police the charitable industry unless the name of such an organization is similar to our registered trade name or trademark. In such a case we already know exactly what authorities to contact to bring an end to fraudsters that may blemish our good name. Trust that the name "Bikers Against Heroin" and "Bikers Against Heroin USA", as related to federal ID numbers 82-0710019 & 82-4040088, has a "good name" and the above trademark logo deserves public confidence.

A federal ID number identifies the corporate entity in the same way a Social Security Number identifies an individual person. Our entity is in good standing and will remain so.

Bikers Against Heroin USA is a registered charitable organization through the State of Ohio and is registered as a 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization with the federal government and the IRS. The same records that we allow to be publicly audited are the ones we report to these agencies. And these agency criminally prosecute officers of corporations who commit charity fraud.

Program Description

Although we have designed a public disclosure system that makes our financial records reviewable by the public, we also have a system that allows our internal comprehensive programs, such as this program, to be reviewed. Anybody who cares enough to review our information and make comments will be appreciated as an "Active Supporter". We love you and in a sense, we belong to you. Opioid addiction is OUR problem, Bikers Against Heroin did not cause it nor will Bikers Against Heroin solve it. It will be solved by supporters period. Supporters scrutinizing organizations regarding this cause is a good thing as we see it. The more people who take advantage of this program, the better we look!

This program allows you or ANYONE to apply for an audit appointment and review the transactional records. We encourage you to print our financial records as published online and then decide which line you want to audit. You can audit all of them if you wish. When you audit a particular line, such as "Charitable Contributions", we will show you the detail of every transaction related to the total. The only exception to this rule is that donors who ask to remain anonymous will remain anonymous. However, the individual amount and the actual bank deposit can be disclosed.

More importantly are the expense items. Maybe someone would like to know what the details are related to the period ending 7/31/2017 for "Administrative: Org Function: Advertisement and Marketing \$384.77". No problem, we got that!

Are you interested in our *Ride Free Program*? Would you like to know our process as to how we administer the program? Would you like to know the amounts we paid out for beneficiaries? Oops, there's another rule! The Health Information Protection Affordability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) prohibits us from releasing the names of the beneficiaries who have applied or received treatment through our program, but we can and will show you how much was paid to who and when. This program does not pay the beneficiary but pays airlines, travel agencies and other transportation related companies.

Organizational Structure

As you have seen above there are two federal identification numbers for two separate entities. That's because the local chapter, the one that conducts the local events from Medina County, Ohio is a separate operation from our national corporation. Every chapter, and we're adding more chapters very soon, is independently operated and will have a federal identification number of their own - and we'll disclose their records also. As an affiliated chapter, they must comply with the terms of their affiliation agreement and the Public Audit Program program is one of the requirements. Would you like to see what our affiliate chapter requirements are?

When completing the Public Audit Application you will need to identify which entity you desire to audit and that application is a process through the national organization. We make sure that your request is properly approved in a timely manner. How's that? Guaranteed approval!

Public Statement

At the heart of the matter we are bikers here. We're not notorious for our formality or technical complexity but were doing our best. As an organization providing assistance to opioid addicts we may even have individuals with less than a perfect criminal record serving as volunteers, members of our board of directors or even officers. Many of our supporters have a drug use history. Who among you shall judge a person from the government's record of their past? Who among you shall determine a person's worth based upon a government record or rumour? Who knows the truth of any such matter? It would be hypocritical to build this organization exclusively from a stock of people who have no experience with the tribulations of life.

Listen, we are the REAL DEAL here! Bikers Against Heroin has a real soul and a real heart and we'll back up our organization's activities with true transactional records and real results that help real people and save real lives. But if you want to attack our supporters, our volunteers, our board members or our officers maybe you should join the *Prison Industrial Complex* and fight the opioid epidemic by throwing everyone into prison for life. That's not our approach. We are in the business of preserving life, not destroying it.

Now, be assured we are no fans of opioid dealers, which includes pharmaceutical gangsters that rake in billions at the costs of the very lives we are trying to save. All drug use, other than opioids, combined is not killing 50,000 people per year, although they may be putting thousands into prison. Bikers Against Heroin is not a defense fund to protect anyone from criminality, we are an organization focused upon our cause, nothing more.
