## Curriculum and Assessment Review by the Department for Education 2025

You may have heard in the news recently that the Department for Education has been consulting on changes to the school's Curriculum and Assessment models. While nothing will change in the immediate future, big changes are ahead and will impact on pupils in the next few years. Changes include:

- A New National Curriculum from 2028.
- Scrapping the concept of the English Baccalaureate.
- Introducing tests for both Maths and English in Year 8.
- Mandatory Citizenship lessons for all pupils.
- New GCSE specifications to be introduced over the next 5 years.
- Triple Science entitlement.

The new curriculum will be implemented in full for first teaching from September 2028. The DfE is aiming to publish the final revised curriculum by Spring 2027 to give schools a full four terms to prepare for the changes. The timeline is summarised below.


#### Being a Responsible Citizen






