Portchester Community School Careers Programme 2023-24

The aims of our Careers Programme are to provide all pupils with the opportunity to explore a wide range of career pathways through a variety of means including:

- Subject specific talks including during National Careers week
 - Mentoring meetings
 - TED talks throughout the year
 - meaningful contact with employees and employers
 - visits to different work environments
 - Work Experience placements
 - impartial careers advice via one to one interviews
 - access to a selection of specific recognised websites

Pupils will have the opportunity to engage in activities at Post 16 providers and in events designed specifically to challenge stereotypes. Through these opportunities and the sharing of information about the local labour markets, our aim is to ensure pupils can achieve their aspirations by making informed choices when choosing their options and transitioning out of the school.

The programme addresses all 8 of the Gatsby benchmarks and recognises the importance of providing accurate information and resources for parents and carers to ensure they are able to support their young person along their learning and career journey. Feedback from a range of stakeholders informs the programme.
