1. Teaching

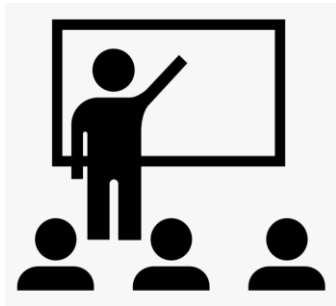
Quality teaching and learning-

Using strong recruitment and purposeful training, effective teaching and use of other adults in the classroom to enable sustained pupil progress.

Reading and Literacy-using specific resources to raise pupils individual reading ages; extending pupils vocabulary through carefully selected texts, learning and whole school activities .

Pathways- using a range of pupil pathways to enable all pupils, irrespective of their needs and perceived barriers to engage and be successful in their learning experience.

Our plan provides be-spoke learning journeys and support tailored to our pupil premium pupils' individual needs



2. Targeted academic support

Mentoring- staff support individual Year 11 pupils with their learning journey, subject specific interventions and post 16 plans

Literacy and Numeracy – small groups interventions are delivered by specialist teaching staff and support staff

3. Wider strategies

Effective transition- providing personalised support when pupils join the school.

Enrichment opportunities-extending pupils educational, social and cultural experiences through activities and financial support.

Raising Aspirations –through tailored careers guidance and exploration of a range of career pathways

Attendance- using early intervention and be-spoke support to tackle barriers to improved attendance.

Supporting social and mental wellbeing- through specific, prioritised support from the pastoral teams, outside agencies and through the tailored tutor programme
