







## Dear Parents and Carers

This has been an extremely busy term for all members of our school community, especially Year 11 pupils who have been busy securing a range of Post 16 offers ready for confirmation in August after they receive their final GCSE outcomes. Mock exams are well underway, and pupils should receive feedback before their Parents' Evening on Wednesday 27 November.

Reminder: Wednesday 27 November is also an INSET Day for school staff and, therefore, the school will not be open to pupils until 3.30 pm for sporting fixtures, and 4.00 pm for the Year 11 Parents' Evening.

Following our Ofsted inspection earlier in the year, the Local Authority have completed their annual health check on the school this term. County Inspectors reviewed this year's GCSE outcomes, interviewed School and Subject Leaders, as well as speaking to pupils and visiting lessons. 


