**Dear Parents and Carers** 

## Reopening of Portchester Community School to all students from 8 March 2021

The government has announced that schools will reopen to all students from **8 March 2021**. We are really looking forward to welcoming back more of our students to face-to-face education. From Monday 8 March 2021, we will be starting our staggered return to school for each Year group and our mass testing programme. Currently, we have over 100 students attending school weekly for a variety of reasons, mainly due to being children of key workers who are helping to keep the county healthy and well.

**School attendance:** The latest <u>government guidance</u> states that we can welcome students back on a safe phased basis during the week of 8 March 2021. The idea of the phased return is to support the safe returning process and enable the whole school coronavirus testing programme to begin.

During the week beginning 8 March 2021, we will be starting our phased return. Please see the information below to identify which day your child will be returning. Current key worker groups will continue to attend as normal.

in Lateral Flow Testing in school. Students are to complete 3 tests on-site before being issued with a home testing kit. If you have not completed the consent form, please do so as quickly as possible, even if you are not giving consent. The tests are not compulsory, but are one strategy for helping to keep our community safe. The link to the form is detailed below:

School attendance will be mandatory and our usual rules on attendance will apply.

As a reminder, students should self-isolate and not come to school if they:

- > Have coronavirus symptoms or have tested positive.
- **\rightarrow** Live with someone who has symptoms or have tested positive.
- > Are a close contact of someone who has tested positive.

In line with the latest government guidance, students who are **clinically extremely vulnerable should not attend school**. If your child is in this group, they should continue to learn from home until further notice. Please contact the school so that specific arrangements can be made.

## Coronavirus testing

To help us keep everyone safe, we will be offering rapid coronavirus testing to all of our students as they return from 8 March 2021. Students will be asked to take 3 coronavirus tests at school, with 3 to 5 school days between each test. Test results will take about 30 minutes to process. Students can return to school after their first negative result. If, at any point, they test positive, they will need to self-isolate in line with government guidance.

After the 3 initial tests at school, students will be offered coronavirus test kits that they should use twice a week at home.

## Our safety measures

Rest assured that we are doing everything we can to make sure our students can return to school safely.

From 8 March 2021, we will be taking the following protective measures:

- > All students (unless exempt) will wear a face covering in classrooms, communal areas and corridors. This is in line with the latest government guidance for schools. Staff will instruct students if masks can be removed, for example, in PE lessons.
- > Students are to wear Portchester PE kit to school on the days they are timetabled for PE.
- > There will be a staggered end to the school day. Years 7 and 8 leaving at 3.00 pm each day and Years 9, 10 and 11 leaving at 3.10 pm each day.
- > Cashless catering will restart from Monday 8 March and food will be served at first break only. Please ensure that your child's card is charged for use if needed.
- **>** Each classroom will be wiped clean between each lesson.
- > New cleaning staff will be regularly cleaning frequent touch points and communal areas.

All student timetables will be live on the Class Charts system by Tuesday morning. We are returning on a Week 1 to one hour specialist lessons.

I would also like to thank you for all your support in helping your child learn from home. We will continue to keep in touch if we update our plans or if we need to make changes due to new government guidance.
