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How to avoid catching or spreading microbes

There are things you can do to help stop viruses like coronavirus spreading.

Do:

- ✓ cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- ✓ put used tissues in the bin immediately
- ✓ wash your hands with soap and water often – use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- ✓ try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell

Don't:

- ✗ do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean

Keeping myself safe and respecting others

- ▶ Year group bubbles
- ▶ The school day- including breakfast and homework club
- ▶ Arrival and departure from school- including what to do if late
- ▶ What to bring/not bring to school
- ▶ Uniform
- ▶ Designated outside spaces, toilets and hand sanitising facilities
- ▶ Tutor time arrangements
- ▶ Moving around the school

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Keeping myself safe and respecting others

Masks

- ▶ Carry one at all times
- ▶ Keep it in a bag to protect it
- ▶ Make sure your hands are clean before you put it on and take it off
- ▶ If you use a reusable mask and it is damp, you must put it in a bag and clean it before wearing it again
- ▶ If you use a disposable one, you must put it in the non recyclable bin once you have finished using it
- ▶ Think about how you travel to school - if you travel on a bus you must wear one

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Keeping myself safe and respecting others

In the classroom

- ▶ Sit in seat as outlined by the teacher
- ▶ Only use the resources on the desk
- ▶ Do not share resources - this includes pens, scissors, glue sticks
- ▶ Place any used equipment where told to by the teacher
- ▶ Leave the classroom as instructed by the teacher
- ▶ Raise your hand and ask if you are not sure
- ▶ Remain in your seat unless directed by the teacher
- ▶ Do not take any resources from the lesson home unless directed to by the teacher

- ▶ Break and lunchtime arrangements
- ▶ What to do if I feel ill at school?
- ▶ What to do if I feel ill at home?
- ▶ Behaviour expectations
- ▶ What to do if I need to speak to someone from the pastoral team?

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Key Points

- ▶ Arrive no earlier than 8:30am on Monday morning
- ▶ Enter down the main drive and up into school via the fire escape to the Maths department. (If you use school transport, you will go via SEN)
