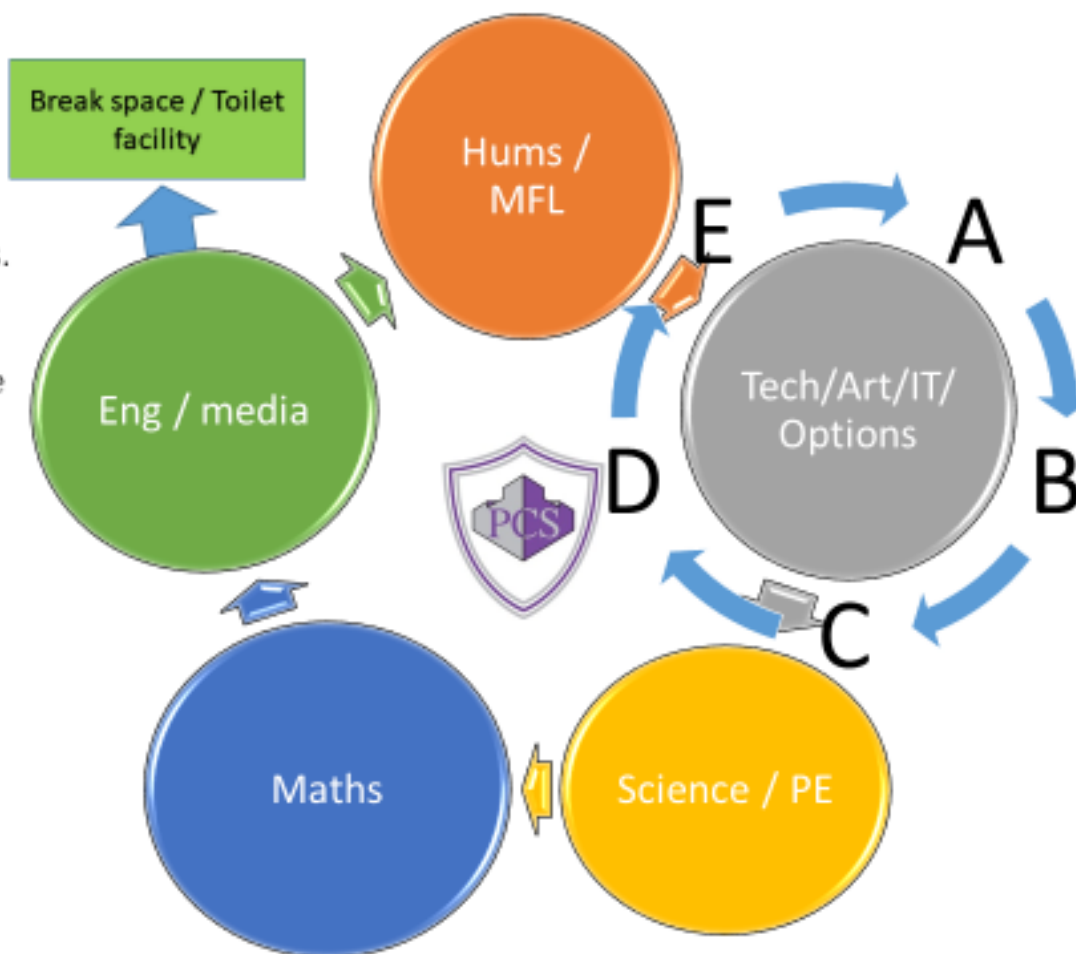

# Year 11 September 2020 Stay Safe

*‘What if I feel ill at school?’ Notify teacher, who will contact medical. Medical staff will come to you.*

*‘What if I feel ill at home?’ Follow government guidelines, if necessary contact 111. Keep school informed, first point of contact should be Year Office.*

*‘What if I need to speak to a member of Year Office?’ A member of the Year team will follow your bubble each day so will be available to support when necessary.*



# Year 11 September 2020 Stay Safe

## Masks:

- Carry one at all times
- Keep it in a bag to protect it
- Make sure your hands are clean before you put it on and take it off
- If you use a reusable mask and it is damp, you must put it in a bag and clean it before wearing it again
- If you use a disposable one, you must put it in the non recyclable bin once you have finished using it
- Think about how you travel to school- if you travel on a bus you must wear one
- When to/ not wear one around school

Every piece of work counts this year, it may all be used as evidence if some/all exams are cancelled

Teachers will support you all the way through the year and make sure you are ready for the exams.



# Year 11 September 2020 Exams

Remember

Everyone nationally is in the same position

A lot of schools have done nothing since March, you continued working so are ahead of many other students!

Your teachers have been working hard to adapt lessons to ensure you are fully prepared

Don't waste a single lesson – every piece of work really may count!

It can be spread from person to person by coughing or touching surfaces or areas of skin that have been contaminated by the virus.

## How to avoid catching or spreading microbes

There are things you can do to help stop viruses like coronavirus spreading.

### Do:

- ✓ cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- ✓ put used tissues in the bin immediately
- ✓ wash your hands with soap and water often – use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- ✓ try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell
