Dear Centro de Folklor Family:

We find ourselves in unprecedented times in regards to the coronavirus (COVID-19). The staff at Centro de Folklor would like to thank you for your patience and understanding. The safety and well-being of our students, parents and volunteer staff is of utmost importance to us.

Here is a plan of action we are taking at Centro de Folklor:

Common Sense Prevention: We ask that if a child or adult is sick in any way, please stay home, rest and get better, but do not go to the studio. As mentioned before the studio is replete with hand sanitizer, sanitizer wipes and disinfectant spray. The studio will go through two deep cleans a day.

March 16 - March 19: Centro de Folklor will continue to run classes this week for those who feel comfortable showing up. If you are a parent please be present during the last ten minutes of class for an Important Parent Meeting.

March 20 - April 12: Centro de Folklor will NOT be running regular scheduled classes. Our hope is that we will be able to resume regular scheduled classes on Monday, April 13.

YouTube Tutorials: Each of our instructors will be making a video with the dances the students are learning. Since schools which have been shut down will be requiring students to do some kind of physical activity, we encourage our dancers to practice their dances at home.

Adult Classes: Members of the Beginning Adult Class, The Comeback Class, and The Irene Gonzalez Project will still run classes, but they are NOT mandatory. Again, if you are not feeling well or show any cold or flu symptoms please stay home.

Spring Break: The studio will be completely shut down during Spring Break from April 3 - April 12.
