APPLICANTS: 18-30 years old college students, non-native Speakers of Chinese, non-Chinese nationality.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

1. The competition will include 2 parts: Speech & Performance.
2. The speech and performance should be:
 - i. Speech, maximum of 3 minutes - 70% of the total score.
 - ii. Cultural performance, maximum 5 minutes - 30% of total score.
(Cultural demonstration or “talent” such as: dance, martial arts, *Xiang-sheng*, poetry, skit, song, instrumental music, Kung fu, etc.)
 - iii. The speech and the performance should be in MP4 video format.
