Housekeeping

Please remind your children to remain respectful of teachers, peers, and themselves and to make wise choices. Related to this, our goal is always to call homework room at 4:00. That said, we also allow the students a minimum of 20 minutes outside. If students are rowdy during the snack process, this will delay our arrival outside and will push back homework room.

We will begin requiring that any student caught playing games during homework room time will have to sit near the homework room teacher for one week. If this is a policy you would like your child excluded from, please let us know and we'll do our best to accommodate. Note: we do allow fun screens after 4:30 on Friday.

Required Distribution

As a licensed facility, we are required by DHS to distribute information on the flu shot to our parents every year. There will be a document to sign indicating you've received this information. We are NOT required to make your child have a flu shot and are not required to note your documentation status, simply required to have you indicate that we've given information. We are going to try to complete this sign off within ProCare, but will do it with Paper if the ProCare process is unsuccessful.
