2	Getting or spreading Coronavirus in the ground and facilities	Players Supporters Coaches Management Matchday Staff Committee	Install soap & hand sanitizer in all public areas Signage to remind people of social distancing One-way system in place in main club areas and access points Temperature checks will be taken on arrival to the ground; admittance to the ground will be refused if temperature is above 37.8 degrees Away teams to submit names of all those associated with the club prior to attendance with contact numbers for track and trace	check before and after every game and event to ensure that soap and sanitizer stations are replenished Share club COVID19 guidelines Implement track and trace if required	Committee Matchday Staff Cleaners	Open and closure of ground	Ongoing

4	Getting or spreading Coronavirus In clubhouse, changing rooms, toilet facilities, entry it points	Players Supporters Coaches Management Matchday Staff Committee	Only one member of staff in T-hut and Bar at any one time Changing rooms will be open for both teams and officials – but social distancing should always be observed T-hut and Bar facilities will be available with one-way systems in place and numbers will be controlled All footballs and training equipment should be cleaned before and after training sessions and matches Players should arrive in kit where possible and encouraged to shower at home Players should bring their own water bottle Limit number of people allowed in toilets to 1 at a time Space out tables in bar area by 2m where space allows Provide sanitizer on entry and as indicated in point 2 above	Spot check to ensure control is carried out Ensure adequate supplies of PPE is always made available . 5	Injuries or Illness	Players Supporters Coaches Management Matchday Staff Committee	<p><b>Before travelling to training, match or event</b> If you are suffering from:- high temperature above 37.8C, a new continuous cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, , loss of taste or smell, feel generally unwell or have been in close contact with someone who is <b>DO NOT</b> travel to the match – call 111 for further guidance.</p> <p><b>At the match</b> Temperature checks will be taken prior to access to the ground; where high temperature above 37.8 is registered, entry will be refused First aiders and/or physio must wear gloves and facemask when attending to players; and after each incident change gloves and use hand sanitizer</p>	Ensure all managers, coaches and players understand the guidance Ensure all managers check for any indication of illness prior to training or match Log all players at training, matches or events in case of an incident and need to update them should a positive case be identified	Managers Coaches Players First Aider Physio Matchday Staff Committee		Ongoing
7	Transmission and spread of COVID19 during events and with spectators	Spectators Volunteers Committee	<p>Temperature checks will be taken prior to access to the ground; where high temperature above 37.8 is registered, entry will be refused</p> <p>Contact Name and Number will be requested prior to entry to allow track and trace if required</p> <p>Marked out 2m sections for groups of no more than 6 people around pitch area</p> <p>One-way system in place in main club areas and access points</p> <p>Reduced seating areas, to adhere to 2 m distance</p> <p>Clean all seats prior to start of games with antibacterial or virus spray</p>	Monitor and ensure guidelines are followed Put up clear signage and notices to ensure people follow social distancing Challenge where necessary Share club COVID19 guidelines	Committee Members	Prior to all events	Ongoing
