2	Getting or spreading Coronavirus in the ground and facilities – <u>Prior to arrival</u>	ALL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Whilst supporters are not allowed into the ground we will require:- -Away teams to submit a list of players, officials and committee members who will be attend Worthing United's ground on match days -U18s must provide name of parent accompanying them – only one is permitted If you are suffering from:- high temperature above 37.8C, a new continuous cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, feel generally unwell or have been in close contact with someone who is <u>DO NOT</u> travel to the match Follow government advice when travelling to the ground 	Check all risks mitigated Visible Club Representatives available	ALL		

2	Getting or spreading Coronavirus in the ground and facilities – <u>On arrival</u>	ALL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One-way system will be in place Track & Trace check in via NHS app on arrival Social distancing is in place; with signs for reinforcement Sanitizer in all public areas and freely available Masks should be worn in all indoor facilities: bar (when open), changing rooms (when open) & toilets 	Check all risks mitigated Visible Club Representatives available	Committee Matchday Staff Cleaners	Open and closure of ground	Ongoing
4	Getting or spreading Coronavirus at the club <u>Around the ground</u>	ALL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> T-Hut facilities will only serve drinks and confectionary until supporters are allowed back into the ground Bar remains closed in STEP 1 Changing Rooms can now be used again, however clubs MUST ensure that their use is strictly limited and should not allow the whole team in at same time. Team Talks etc should be held on the pitch - a designated area will be provided for both home and away teams One-way system in place where possible Reduced seating areas to adhere to 2 m distance Rule of 6 will be in place Messages of reinforcement on social distancing will be made over the speaker system before, during and after matches when supporters are present Masks should be worn in all indoor facilities including toilets 	Check all risks mitigated Visible Club Representatives available	Managers Coaches Committee Matchday Staff	Open and closure of ground	Ongoing

8	Getting or spreading Coronavirus at the club <u>After the game</u>	ALL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All kit must be sanitised thoroughly after use Changing rooms when in use must be deep cleaned Clean all seats prior to start of games with antibacterial or virus spray 	Check all risks mitigated Visible Club Representatives available	Committee Members	Post events	Ongoing
