MANAGERS' THOUGHTS

LATE EQUALIZER DENIES MAVERICKS ALL 3 POINTS MILE OAK 1–1 WORTHING UNITED

WORTHING UNITED WERE FORCED TO SETTLE FOR A POINT AWAY AT MILE OAK AFTER A DRAMATIC FINAL 15 MINUTES SAW THE MAVERICKS TAKE THE LEAD, MISS A PENALTY AND THEN CONCEDE A LATE EQUALISER.

IT WAS A HARD-FOUGHT ENCOUNTER, WITH MILE OAK MAKING LIFE DIFFICULT FOR UNITED AND ENSURING CHANCES WERE AT A PREMIUM FOR LONG PERIODS.

AT THE BACK, ANDREW YOUNGER WAS OUTSTANDING AT CENTRE HALF, SETTING THE TONE WITH AN AGGRESSIVE AND COMMITTED DISPLAY. YOUNGER ATTACKED EVERYTHING THAT CAME HIS WAY, COMPETED STRONGLY THROUGHOUT AND GAVE UNITED A REAL PHYSICAL PRESENCE AT THE HEART OF THE DEFENCE.

WITH THE GAME STILL GOALLESS HEADING INTO THE FINAL STAGES, THE BREAKTHROUGH FINALLY ARRIVED IN THE 75TH MINUTE. UNITED WON A FREE KICK IN A DANGEROUS POSITION AND DEAN SHERWOOD STEPPED UP, PRODUCING A SUPERB STRIKE TO BEAT THE MILE OAK GOALKEEPER AND GIVE THE MAVERICKS A 1–0 LEAD.

JUST THREE MINUTES LATER, UNITED WERE HANDED A GOLDEN OPPORTUNITY TO PUT THE GAME BEYOND THE HOSTS.

THE REFEREE POINTED TO THE PENALTY SPOT IN THE 78TH MINUTE, WITH SHERWOOD AGAIN TAKING RESPONSIBILITY. HAVING SCORED MOMENTS EARLIER, HE HAD THE CHANCE TO MAKE IT 2–0, BUT THE PENALTY WAS MISSED AND MILE OAK WERE GIVEN A LIFELINE.

UNFORTUNATELY FOR THE MAVERICKS, IT WAS ONE THEY WOULD TAKE.

MILE OAK PUSHED FORWARD LOOKING FOR A WAY BACK INTO THE CONTEST AND IN THE 85TH MINUTE FOUND THE EQUALISER TO MAKE IT 1–1.

UNITED PUSHED AGAIN IN THE CLOSING STAGES BUT COULDN'T FIND THE DECISIVE SECOND GOAL, MEANING THE POINTS WERE SHARED.

THERE WILL UNDOUBTEDLY BE FRUSTRATION FOR WORTHING UNITED. HAVING WORKED HARD TO GET THEMSELVES IN FRONT AND THEN HAVING THE OPPORTUNITY TO ESTABLISH A TWO-GOAL CUSHION, THE MAVERICKS WERE JUST FIVE MINUTES AWAY FROM TAKING ALL THREE POINTS.

NEVERTHELESS, IT WAS ANOTHER POINT ON THE BOARD FROM A DIFFICULT AWAY FIXTURE AND ANOTHER BATTLING PERFORMANCE FROM A SIDE CONTINUING TO SHOW PLENTY OF CHARACTER.

MATT & JACOB

On the 22nd August 2015 the club was hit by tragedy when Matthew Grimstone and Jacob Schilt were lost in the Shoreham Air Disaster. The team did not play again until 6th September, when they faced East Preston in an FA Vase tie. The match was played in front of more than 1000 spectators and the Mavericks won the game 2-1 in dramatic fashion.

Every year the Sussex County FA holds memorial games in loving memory of Matt & Jacob. Matt & Jacob will always be remembered at the club. We have built the memorial stand to honour their name and we have the memorial garden which was constructed through donations of materials, and labour from local tradespersons, and businesses. Within the club house you will also see many other tributes dedicated to Matt & Jacob.

In 2025, to coincide with the 10th Anniversary of the Shoreham Air Crash, the Mavericks announced that the number 1 and 11 shirts would be permanently retired in Matt and Jacob's memory. The shirts were presented to the Grimstone and Schilt families at the annual memorial match so they are theirs forever.

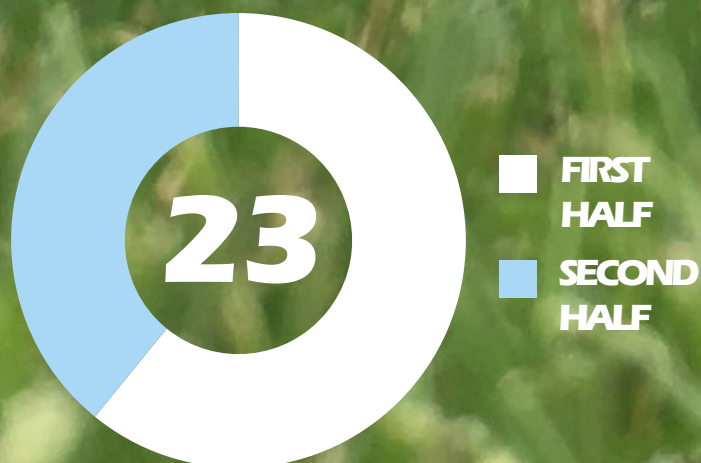

ABOUT THE OPPOSITION



CLANFIELD FC WAS FORMED IN 1983 WITH THE MERGING OF CLANFIELD SENIORS AND CLANFIELD BOYS CLUB TO ESTABLISH A SINGLE CLUB FOR THE AREA. IN OUR RELATIVELY SHORT HISTORY WE HAVE BUILT UP A STRONG INFRASTRUCTURE BOTH ON AND OFF THE PITCH AND THIS HAS ENABLED US TO RUN TEAMS RANGING FROM BOYS AND GIRLS YOUTH TEAMS UP TO SENIOR LEVEL. CLANFIELD FC'S HOME GROUND HAS BEEN PEEL PARK SINCE THE CLUB WAS FORMED WITH CHANGES OVER THE YEARS TO ACCOMMODATE THE LEAGUE STANDARDS REQUIRED TO PLAY AT HAMPSHIRE LEVEL. UNFORTUNATELY, THE RESTRICTIONS AT PEEL PARK MEAN THAT PROGRESSION BEYOND THE HAMPSHIRE PREMIER LEAGUE REQUIRED THE 1ST TEAM TO SEEK AN ALTERNATIVE HOME TO PLAY AT. IN 2019 WE AGREED A GROUNDSHARE ARRANGEMENT WITH HAVANT & WATERLOOVILLE FC AND STARTED PUTTING TOGETHER PLANS TO SECURE PROMOTION INTO THE

WESSEX LEAGUE. AS A CLUB, OUR MOST SUCCESSFUL PERIOD TO DATE WAS IN THE 90s; WINNING THE PORTSMOUTH & DISTRICT LEAGUE AT ALL LEVELS THEN JOINING THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE IN 1997. THE CLUB'S BIGGEST ACHIEVEMENT CAME IN THE 1998/99 SEASON WITH THE CLUB WINNING THE HAMPSHIRE LEAGUE DIVISION 3 TITLE AND THE HAMPSHIRE INTERMEDIATE CUP COMPLETING THE DOUBLE AND MAKING HISTORY FOR THE CLUB. THE CLUB BRIEFLY JOINED THE WESSEX LEAGUE IN EARLY 2000'S UNTIL THE REFORMED HAMPSHIRE PREMIER LEAGUE WAS INTRODUCED FOR SEASON 2007/08 AND THAT IS WHERE THE CLUB STAYED UNTIL WE FINISHED 2ND IN THE 2022/23 SEASON, SECURING OUR PROMOTION TO THE WESSEX LEAGUE DIVISION 1. OUR YOUTH STRUCTURE HAS A PATHWAY THROUGH FROM OUR COLTS SESSIONS THROUGH TO U18S, INCORPORATING 23 YOUTH TEAMS PLAYING IN THE PORTSMOUTH YOUTH LEAGUE, MID SOLENT LEAGUE AND HAMPSHIRE GIRLS LEAGUE. OUR U23S AND RESERVES TEAMS PLAY IN THE HAMPSHIRE COMBINATION AND DEVELOPMENT LEAGUE WHILE IN 2022/23 WE HAD OUR FIRST WOMEN'S TEAM ENTER THE COUNTY WOMEN'S LEAGUE. OUR SUCCESSFUL WEETABIX WILDCATS PROGRAMME HAS HELPED CREATE A THRIVING GIRLS FOOTBALL SECTION, WITH NEARLY HALF OUR YOUTH MEMBERS BEING FEMALE, WITH A NUMBER PLAYING FOR BOTH GIRLS AND MIXED FOOTBALL TEAMS. FOR THIS SEASON WE ARE DELIGHTED TO WELCOME NEW MAIN KIT SPONSORS TO THE CLUB IN STEVE GRANTHAM BESPOKE ESTATE AGENT, JONES & YOUNG MORTGAGE BROKERS, INTERNAL SOLAR, SHIP & BELL HORNDEN AND MURRAY PLANNING.

CLUB HISTORY

WORTHING UNITED FOOTBALL CLUB TRACES ITS ROOTS BACK TO WIGMORE ATHLETIC, WHO WERE FOUNDER MEMBERS OF DIVISION TWO OF THE SUSSEX COUNTY FOOTBALL LEAGUE IN 1952. SUCCESS CAME IMMEDIATELY AS THE CLUB WON THE DIVISION TWO TITLE IN ITS FIRST SEASON AND GAINED PROMOTION TO DIVISION ONE. OVER THE FOLLOWING DECADES, WIGMORE ESTABLISHED ITSELF WITHIN SUSSEX FOOTBALL, WINNING THE LEAGUE CUP IN 1959–60 AND MAKING ITS DEBUT IN THE FA CUP, WHILE ENJOYING SEVERAL PROMOTIONS AND RELEGATIONS BETWEEN THE COUNTY LEAGUE'S TOP TWO DIVISIONS.

THE CLUB'S STORY HAS ALWAYS BEEN SHAPED BY THE DEDICATION OF LOCAL PEOPLE AND FAMILIES. FEW HAVE HAD A GREATER INFLUENCE THAN THE ALBON FAMILY, WHOSE ASSOCIATION WITH THE CLUB SPANS GENERATIONS. ROBERT ALBON REPRESENTED THE CLUB AS A PLAYER AND TRAGICALLY LOST HIS LIFE WHILST PLAYING. IN RECOGNITION OF HIS MEMORY AND THE FAMILY'S OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTION TO WORTHING UNITED, THE CLUB'S HOME AT LYONS FARM BECAME THE ROBERT ALBON MEMORIAL GROUND. ROBERT'S FATHER, BOB ALBON, WAS AMONG THE FOUNDERS OF WORTHING UNITED FOLLOWING THE MERGER OF WIGMORE ATHLETIC AND SOUTHDOWN FC AND LATER SERVED WITH DISTINCTION AS CLUB PRESIDENT FOR MANY YEARS.

IN 1988, FOLLOWING RELEGATION FROM THE SUSSEX COUNTY LEAGUE, WIGMORE ATHLETIC MERGED WITH LOCAL SIDE SOUTHDOWN FC TO FORM WORTHING UNITED FOOTBALL CLUB. THE NEWLY FORMED CLUB QUICKLY REBUILT, WINNING PROMOTION FROM DIVISION THREE AND LATER RETURNING TO THE TOP TIER OF SUSSEX FOOTBALL. NOTABLE SUCCESSES INCLUDED PROMOTION UNDER DOMINIC DI PAOLA IN 2010–11 AND NIGEL GEARY'S LEAGUE AND CUP DOUBLE-WINNING SIDE OF 2014–15. THE FORMATION OF THE CLUB WAS DRIVEN BY DEDICATED VOLUNTEERS, INCLUDING BOB ALBON AND LEN KILLPARTRICK, WHOSE VISION AND COMMITMENT HELPED ESTABLISH THE FOUNDATIONS UPON WHICH WORTHING UNITED CONTINUES TO BUILD TODAY.

WORTHING UNITED HAS ALSO ENDURED MOMENTS OF PROFOUND SADNESS. IN 2015, THE CLUB WAS DEEPLY AFFECTED BY THE LOSS OF PLAYERS MATTHEW GRIMSTONE AND JACOB SCHILT IN THE SHOREHAM AIR CRASH. THE RESPONSE FROM THE FOOTBALL COMMUNITY AND THE CLUB'S SUPPORTERS DEMONSTRATED THE STRENGTH, RESILIENCE AND TOGETHERNESS THAT HAVE ALWAYS BEEN AT THE HEART OF WORTHING UNITED. IN THE IMMEDIATE AFTERMATH OF THE TRAGEDY, THE CLUB RETIRED MATTHEW'S NUMBER 1 SHIRT AND JACOB'S NUMBER 11 SHIRT. TO MARK THE TENTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE SHOREHAM AIR CRASH IN 2025, WORTHING UNITED PERMANENTLY RETIRED BOTH NUMBERS, ENSURING THAT THE MEMORY OF MATTHEW AND JACOB WILL FOREVER REMAIN PART OF THE CLUB'S HISTORY.

ANOTHER FIGURE WHOSE CONTRIBUTION HAS BEEN INSTRUMENTAL TO THE CLUB'S SUCCESS IS MARK SANDERSON. SINCE FIRST BECOMING INVOLVED AS A VOLUNTEER IN 1995, MARK HAS SERVED WORTHING UNITED IN NUMEROUS CAPACITIES AND DEDICATED COUNTLESS HOURS TO ITS DEVELOPMENT BOTH ON AND OFF THE PITCH. TODAY, HE CONTINUES TO PLAY A CENTRAL ROLE AS CHAIRMAN, SECRETARY AND GROUNDSMAN.

FROM ITS BEGINNINGS AS WIGMORE ATHLETIC TO THE PRESENT DAY, WORTHING UNITED HAS REMAINED A COMMUNITY CLUB BUILT ON HARD WORK, LOYALTY AND LOCAL PRIDE. THE FOUNDATIONS LAID BY THE CLUB'S FOUNDERS, THE DEDICATION OF VOLUNTEERS, AND THE COMMITMENT OF GENERATIONS OF PLAYERS, OFFICIALS AND SUPPORTERS HAVE CREATED A CLUB THAT CONTINUES TO THRIVE WHILE HONOURING THE LEGACY OF THOSE WHO HELPED MAKE IT WHAT IT IS TODAY. LEN CONTINUES TO SERVE THE CLUB AS PRESIDENT, PROVIDING AN ENDURING LINK BETWEEN WORTHING UNITED'S FORMATION AND ITS FUTURE.
